Legal Background

-Regulation (EC) No 1099/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 22 October 2008 on Energy Statistics establishes a common framework for the production, transmission , evaluation and dissemination of comparable energy statistics in the Community.



Previous Arrangements

- Previously to this regulation, data was provided under a “Gentlemen’s Agreement” between Member States and the Commission
- In Ireland, SEI has been the data provider, using data from different sources.
- Among those sources are data from CSO Structural Business Statistics surveys: Census of Industrial Production (CIP) and Annual Services Inquiry (ASI)
