United Nationals Agenda 2030 on Sustainable Development

- Sustainable Development is defined as developments that meet the needs of present without comprising the needs of the future generation.
- To achieve Sustainable Development, we need to harmonize the 3 core elements (dimensions/principles) i.e. Sociol inclusion, Economic growth and Environmental protection.

The 2030 Agenda is comprised of four main parts:

- 1) a Declaration, which presents its vision and principles;
- 2) the Sustainable Development Goals;
- 3) the Global Partnership and Means of Implementation and
- 4) the Follow-Up and review.



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STATUES OF SDG IN FIJI

Introduction

- Ministry of Economy's Climate Change and International Cooperation Division (CCICD) is mandated to oversee and drive Fiji's 2030 Sustainable Development Agenda
- The Ministry of Economy (MoE) is Fiji's central coordinating agency on SDG
- Established Unit Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) Unit

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Objectives

- Lead coordination efforts with respective government stakeholders and partners to develop mechanism or framework in tracking Fiji's progress on the SDG.
- Monitor & Review the implementation of the SDG on our national policies and frameworks
- Preparation and development of high-level reports on SDG, such as the Voluntary National Review (VNR)

To achieve this objectives;

- 1. Strategic guidance to support the implementation of SDGs and the related indicators at the national level
 - Establish a national data hub that will consist of a centralized tracking system for all SDG global and national indicators and its progress.
 - Obtain relevant updates, data and inputs on SDG targets and indicators.
 - Develop a frameworks of SDG indicators.
 - Develop new SDG indicators and nationalize this indicator into our national policies and frameworks.

- 2. Advocate and raise awareness, capacity enhancement and knowledge development on all SDG related activities
 - Provide further advocacy of the SDGs and Fiji's plans to conduct a VNR in 2023.
- 3. Build and encourage strong partnerships among diverse stakeholders and leverage support for the achievement of the 2030 Agenda.
 - Take actions to achieve our Sustainable Development Goals.
- 4. Monitor Fiji's SDG implementation through coordinated approach involving government, NGOs, civil society groups, etc.
 - Strong engagement with line ministries and wider stakeholders to monitor progress on the SDG.

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STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT

- Consultation with government conducting oneon-one meetings on SDG progress.
- Regular and inclusive review progress at the national level – NGOs, CSOs, other stakeholders
- Support UN Systems (UNESCAP & UNDP)

Regional Level



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DATA AND STATISTICS FOR SDG IMPLEMENTATION

Activity 1: Data and Statistics in SDG implementation

- Fiji Bureau of Statistics leading Role
- Fiji National SDG Tracker (Excel) working file
- Fiji National SDG database tracker tool online (UNESCAP)
- Data disaggregation and input, developing a baseline to measure Fiji progress.
- Data processing and summarized in a format for statistical analysis.



Activity 2: DATA HUB (CENTRE)

• Primary elements of a SDG DATA HUB

- Facility/office space
- Core components e.g. equipments, computers, IT, software and programs
- Support infrastructure security (data safety, back up, power surge), safety (fire safety, cooling system, air ventilation, etc)

Activity 2: National Development Plan (5 Years and 20 Years) Review – Phase 1

- MoEconomy: Budget and Planning Division Leading Role (Mr. Turaga – Consultant)
- Phase 1 of the NDP (5 Years) Completed
- Review of the Phase 1 of the NDP
- NDP assessment includes budget utilization

Focus/Objectives

- The review of the NDP (Phase 1 5 Years)
 - What has been achieved
 - What has not been achieved, and why
 - What should be done to enable the achievement of the NDP objectives/targets
 - What new challenges or issues have emerged since the adoption of the NDP
 - How has government been performing for the last 5 years against its NDP and budget utilization



Way Forward

- Opportunities for phase 2 of the NDP
 - Reassess the NDP indicators and impart realistic targets & indicators
 - More NDP indicators may be aligned to the SDG indicators
