Why Tier III?

	Investments in energy efficiency as a percentage of GDP	Amount of foreign direct investment in financial transfer for infrastructure and technology to sustainable development services
Definition	Available, but energy efficiency investments are notoriously difficult to track.	N/A - "sustainable development services"
Relevant work	International Energy Agency (2014)	N/A - FDI data not disaggregated enough to link to "sustainable development services"

Tracking SDG 7: SE4All Global Tracking Framework











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



