## **Background**

- Established by the 46th. Session UNSC (2015)
- Terms of Reference presented to 47th. UNSC (2016) created governance structure:
- Management group,
- Technical working group,
- UNSD Secretariat and
- Advisory panel.
- First Meeting of MG in March 2016.



- Development of standards where they do not exist in HHS, particularly for SDG indicators
- Priority issues/methodologies in specific areas and in cross-cutting issues
- Establishment of task forces with timelines, deliverables and implied costs
- WB, ILO, FAO, UNICEF, UNESCO, UNODC, WHO, DfID, DHS —initially, but plans to broaden.
- Meeting in September 2016: thematic, methods, integration and coordination.
- ILO chairing the MG and the TWG as from Oct 16
- TWG met virtually twice



- Decision to focus on themes ref. SDGs: a)
  measuring food consumption; b) standards
  and best practices in survey data
  documentation;c) Measurement of paid/
  unpaid work; d) Module on Goal 16 indicators;
  e)Education-spending estimates based on
  HHS.
- Inventory of methodological work at the international level on HHS. Quality assurance and Coordination.
- Mapping of SDG indicators measured by HHS

## **Work Plan**

- Mapping for development of an integrated system of household surveys and SDGs.
- State of current and planned activities on HHS
- Not only for SDGs.
- Common issues: periodicity, sample and questionnaire design, modular approach, communication of findings
- Setting standards where they do not exist.
- Capacity building: inventory and guidance materials (draft available)
- Methodological and operational coordination
- Role of the Advisory Panel.
- Resource mobilization
