## **SDG Working Group on SDMX\***

- IAEG-SDGs established the Working Group on SDMX for SDG Indicators in April 2016
   The main task of the Working Group is to develop an SDMX solution for SDG Indicator data and metadata exchange and dissemination
   The Working Group will develop a DSD and MSD for SDG Indicators
   The SDGs DSD will be used to report and disseminate the indicators at national and international levels
- \*SDMX: Statistical Data & Metadata eXchange



## **SDMX-SDGs – Challenges**

- ☐ Diversity of the SDG Indicators
- Possible changes to SDG Indicators
- ☐ Reporting and dissemination at multiple levels
- Number and diversity of stakeholders and counterparties
- ☐ Countries should be able to adapt the DSD to suit their own needs



#### **SDMX-SDGs – Current Status**

At the second meeting of the SDMX-SDGs Working Group in October 2017, a number of outstanding issues were discussed, including:

- Mandatory disaggregation
- Remaining code lists
- Metadata concepts and Metadata Structure Definition

- Pilot data exchange: 2018Q1
- Production data exchange: 2018Q4
- Development of Metadata Structure
   Definition(s) and pilot Metadata Exchange:
   2018Q4
