Practical suggestions for facilitating data flows

Data transmission processes should be made more efficient	Both countries and CAs should discuss existing and emerging transmission needs and opportunities	Arrange workshops to explore existing and potential transmission options
The validation process is unclear		Include on the UNSD SDG dashboard a mechanism to facilitate the validation negotiation process.
A negotiation and resolution process should be established.	Countries and CAs should establish early the collaboration style that works best for them	Arrange workshops and pilots to faciliate country and CA collaboration on data flows


Communication with CAs

An example for the use of national estimates instead of CAs's calculations


15.4.2 – Mountain Green Cover Index
