## Practical suggestions for facilitating data flows

Issue	Suggestion	Tool
Delayed and/or impaired communication due to unclear points of contact.	Identify focal points for countries and CAs.	Post an online dashboard of focal points for countries and CAs.
CA agency monitoring schedules are unclear to countries, resulting in delays	Provide a schedule for CA SDG data requests and updates.	Provide a master schedule for updates of data and metadata for each indicator on the SDGs website
Metadata for requested statistics are unclear, resulting in delays.	Improve communication of global and national metadata	Post an interactive metadata page to allow easier updates of metadata.

## Practical suggestions for facilitating data flows

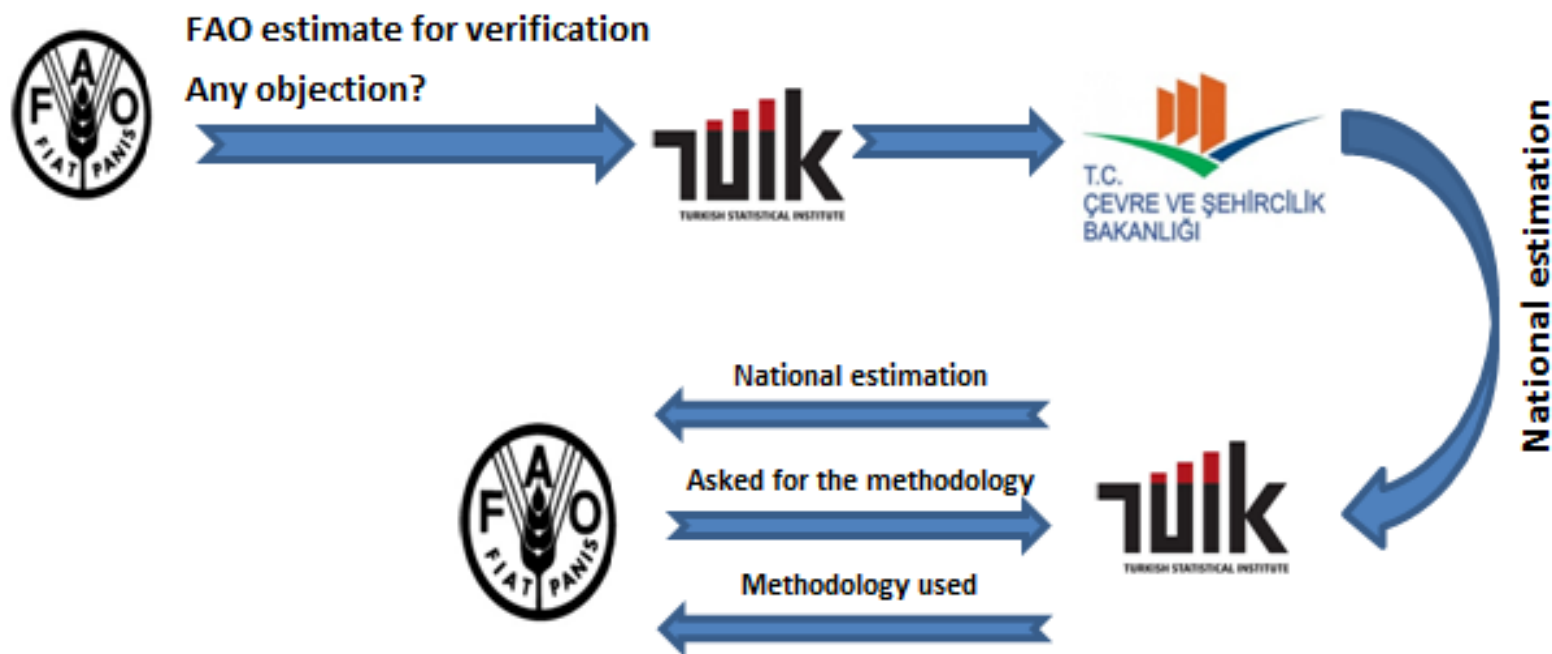
Issue	Suggestion	Tool
Data transmission processes should be made more efficient	Both countries and CAs should discuss existing and emerging transmission needs and opportunities	Arrange workshops to explore existing and potential transmission options
The validation process is unclear	A transparent (and flexible) validation process that allows maturation is needed	Include on the UNSD SDG dashboard a mechanism to facilitate the validation negotiation process.
A negotiation and resolution process should be established.	Countries and CAs should establish early the collaboration style that works best for them	Arrange workshops and pilots to facilitate country and CA collaboration on data flows

- Newly started process with CAs includes on data validation;

  - Co-operation and collaboration facilities in coming years,
  - Data validation,

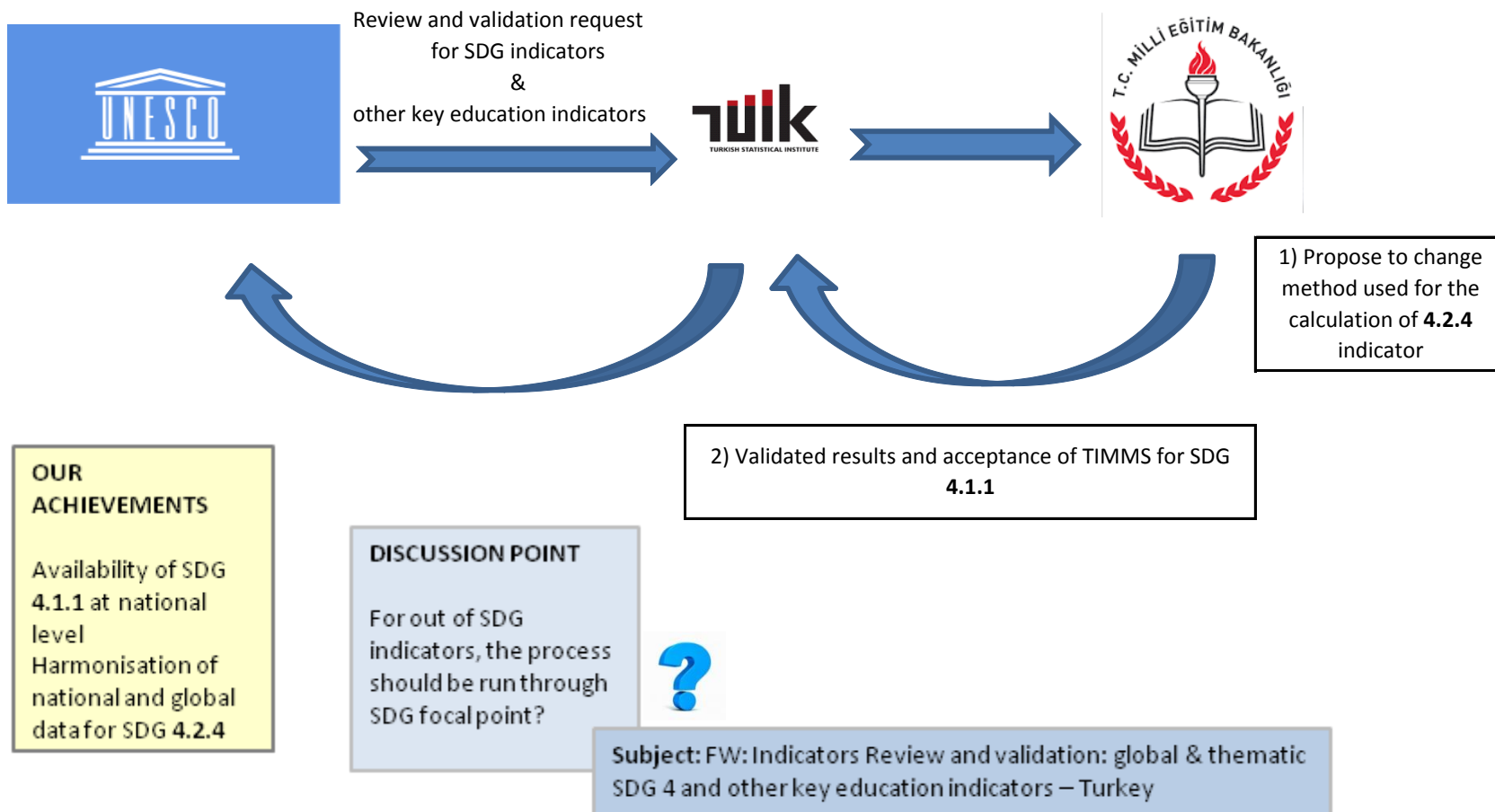
## An example for the use of national estimates instead of CAs's calculations
