9.3.1 Percentage share of small-scale industries in total industry value added	 Size and contribution of small-scale industries
9.3.2 Percentage of small-scale industries in loan or line of credit	 Access of small-scale industries to financial services
9.4.1 CO ₂ emission per unit of value added	 Environment sustainability and energy efficiency
9.b.1 Percentage share of medium and high- tech (MHT) industry value added in total value added	 Technological development and innovation in manufacturing

 - Other relevant publications completed by NSOs
- OECD countries
 - Data collected by OECD and transmitted to UNIDO
 - OECD Structural Business Statistics
- Reports of technical assistance projects
 - Data made available in course of the project implementation

Challenges

- SDG 9.3.1 and 9.3.2 indicators are related to small-scale industrial enterprises ("small-scale industries")
 - 9.3.1 Proportion of small-scale industries in total industry value added
 - 9.3.2 Proportion of small-scale industries with a loan or line of credit
- These indicators intend to measure the role and contribution of "small-scale industries" to industrialization; their access to financial service

Definition for SDG reporting

- Countries are using the designation of "small" based on revenue, amount of initial investment or fixed capital, employment etc.
- For SDG reporting the size class is designated at 20 persons employed which is in line with IRIS 2008
 - 1-9, 10-19, 20-49, 50-249 (no taxonomy is given)
- Survey data by size class is very much limited in developing countries

Progress

Initial data collection

- UNIDO Small Industrial Enterprises Questionnaire (sent to non-OECD countries)
- OECD Structural Business Statistics (OECD countries)
- World Bank Enterprise Surveys access to finance

• 9.3.1

- Coverage: 53 countries (17 non-OECD and 38 OECD countries)
- Information collected by sub-sectors (at 2-digit level)
- 9.3.2
 - Coverage: 133 countries (mostly developing)
 - **Issues:** representativeness of the sample, gaps in time series
