# **SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOAL 13**


Take urgent action to combat climate change and its impacts\*



- Incremental adjustments based on agreements and progress under UNFCCC process; Acknowledging that the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change is the primary international, intergovernmental forum for negotiating the global response to climate change; based on enhanced transparency framework and global stocktake (first taking place in 2023);
- Following IAEG-SDGs guidance on 2020 review and expectations;
- Working in consultation with relevant agencies;
- Aim to make proposals for 2020 review during 2<sup>nd</sup> half of 2019 for your consideration, against targets, in line with current proxies




#### **Global climate change goals**





## **COP 24 outcome: overview**

- Make the Paris agreement operational and its institutions and processes to work efficiently, as well as identify follow-up technical work mostly on transparency
- Advancement in implementation of the Convention in key areas of transparency/MRV, mitigation, adaptation, finance, technology and capacity building, new pledges on climate finance
- Enhancement of political momentum to submission of more ambitious Nationally Determined Contributions in 2020 through the Talanoa dialogue and enable delivery through the pre-2020 events






#### **Enhanced transparency framework**



**Review format:** centralized, incountry, desk, simplified Facilitative, multilateral consideration of progress- scope: GHG inventory, tracking progress towards NDCs, support provided, and support received and needed




## Streamlined/common reporting and verification with flexibility



- Final biennial reports submitted no later than **31 December 2022**
- Final biennial update reports submitted no later than 31 December 2024





## NDCs in 2020 – what is happening

- Parties whose INDC with a time frame up to 2025 to communicate by 2020 a new NDC and to do so every five years thereafter
- Parties whose INDC with a time frame up to 2030 to communicate or update by 2020 the contribution and to do so every five years thereafter;
- The secretariat will prepare a synthesis report (1/CP.21, para. 25);
- All Parties are invited to communicate long-term low emission development strategies (1/CP.21, para. 35);
