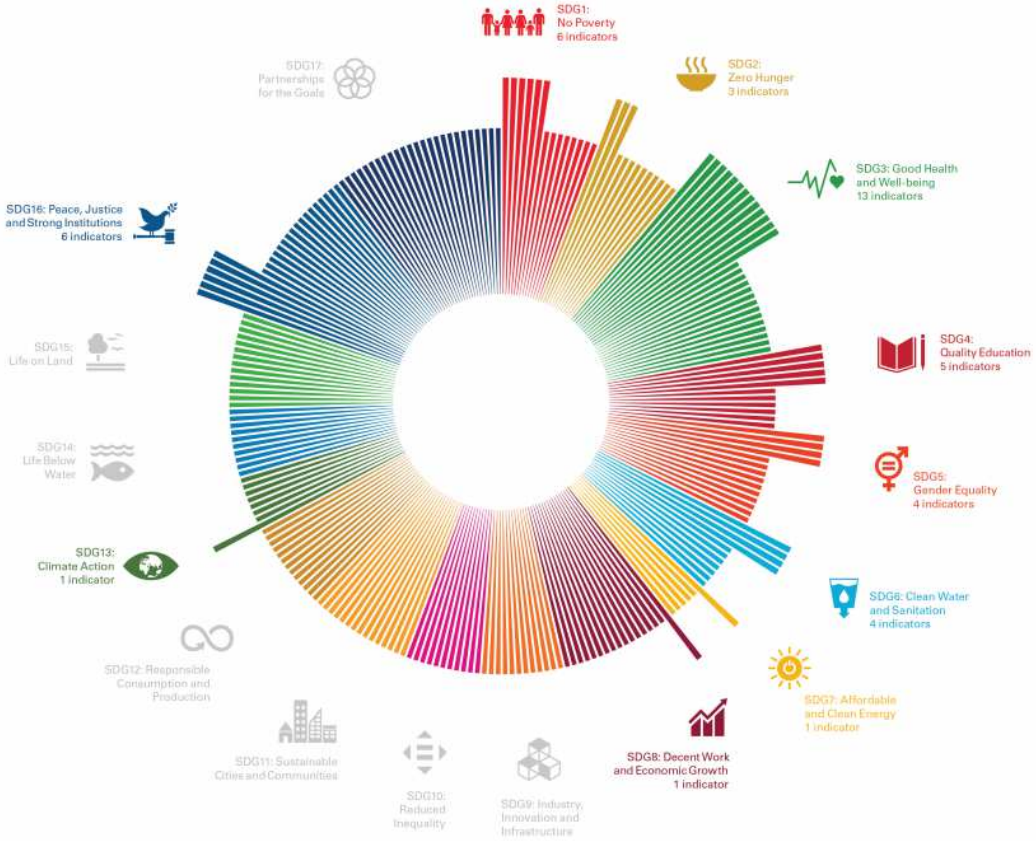

This study aims to understand:

- 1** To what extent countries have adopted child-related SDG targets
- 2** To what extent nationally set SDG targets measure up to the global vision
- 3** To what extent countries have adopted national SDG indicators

Study methodology

- UNICEF Country Offices (COs) were sent an Excel data collection tool
- Tool enquired about the country-specific situation of 23 child-related SDG targets, and 33 indicators

Limitations

- Only child-related targets and indicators were examined
- Responses represent low and middle-income countries
- Time limitations for data collection and the thematic scope of the targets

remain to be set**



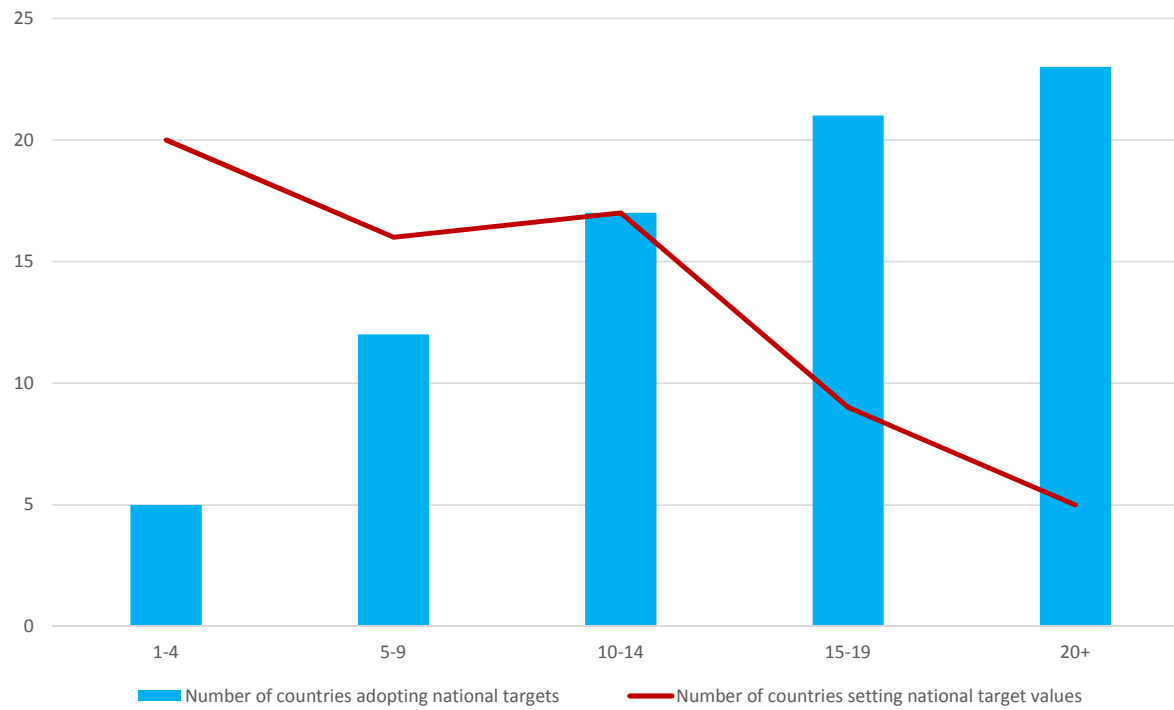
44 countries adopted 15 or more targets

Many national target values remain to be set

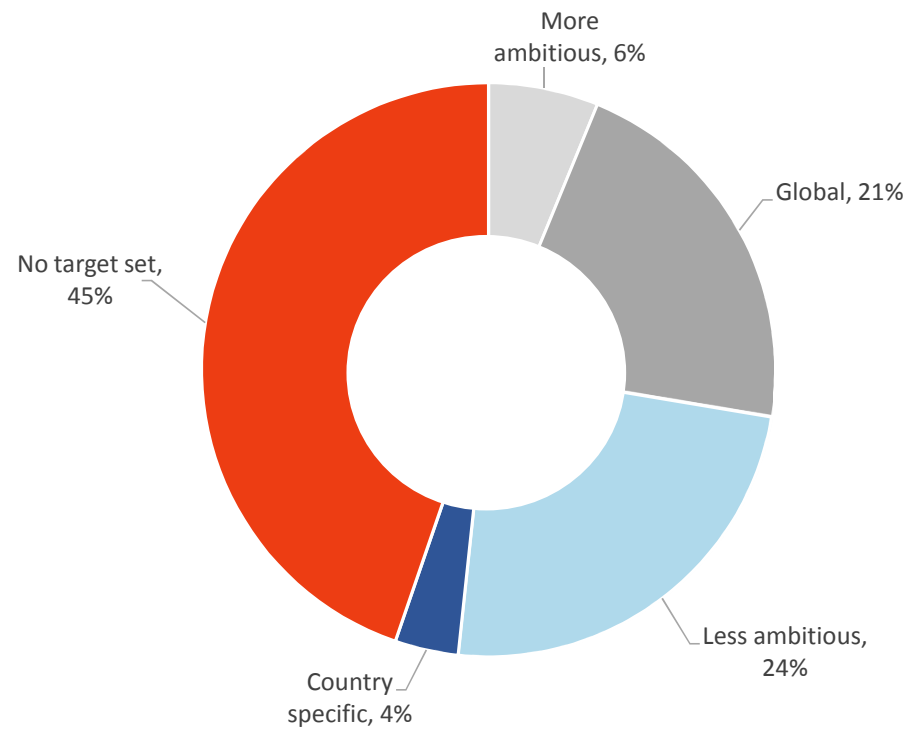

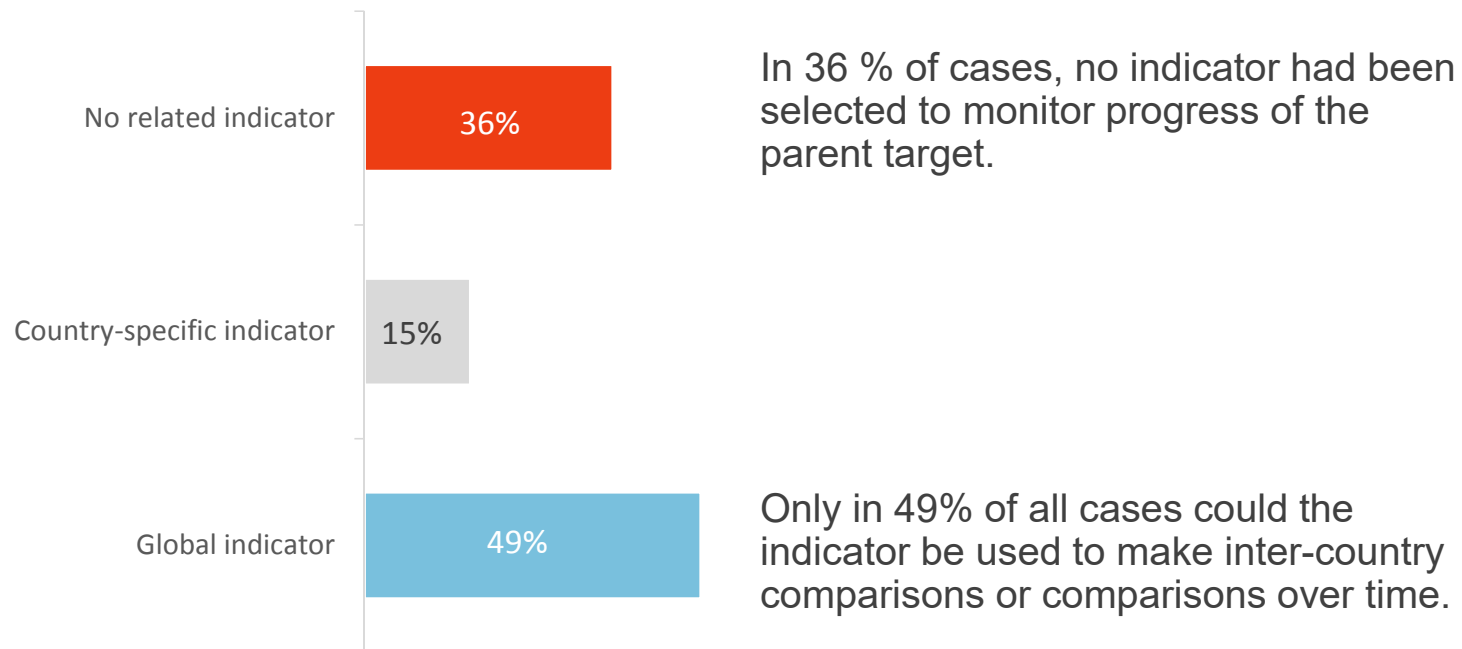

Target ambition levels

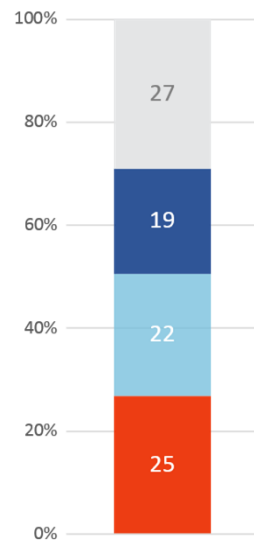
In **45%** of cases, no target had been set, making it hard to measure ambition levels of national target values



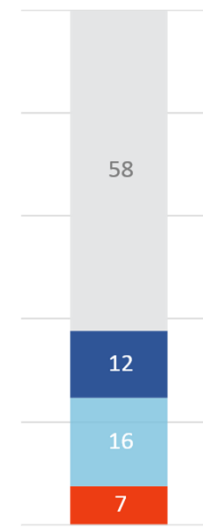
Use of global SDG indicators in national development strategies to monitor child-related targets

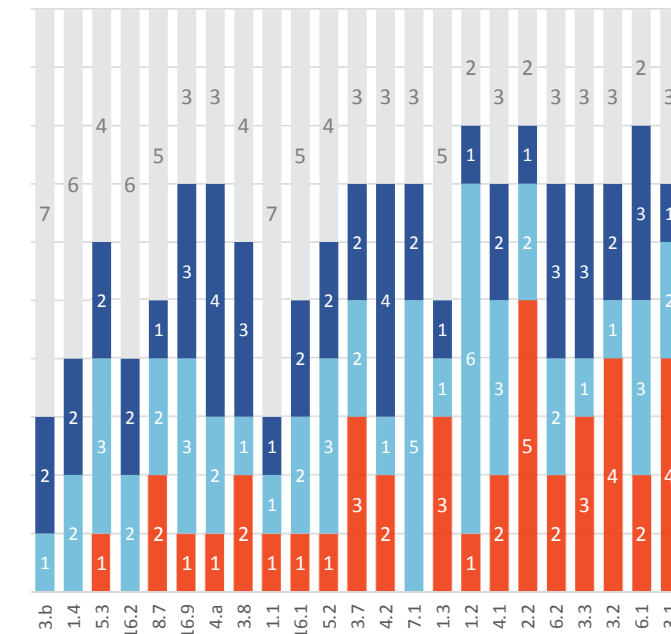

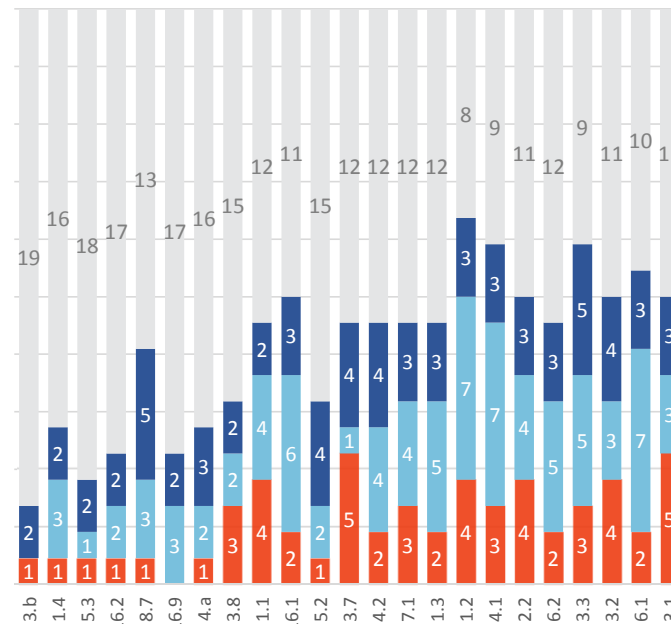

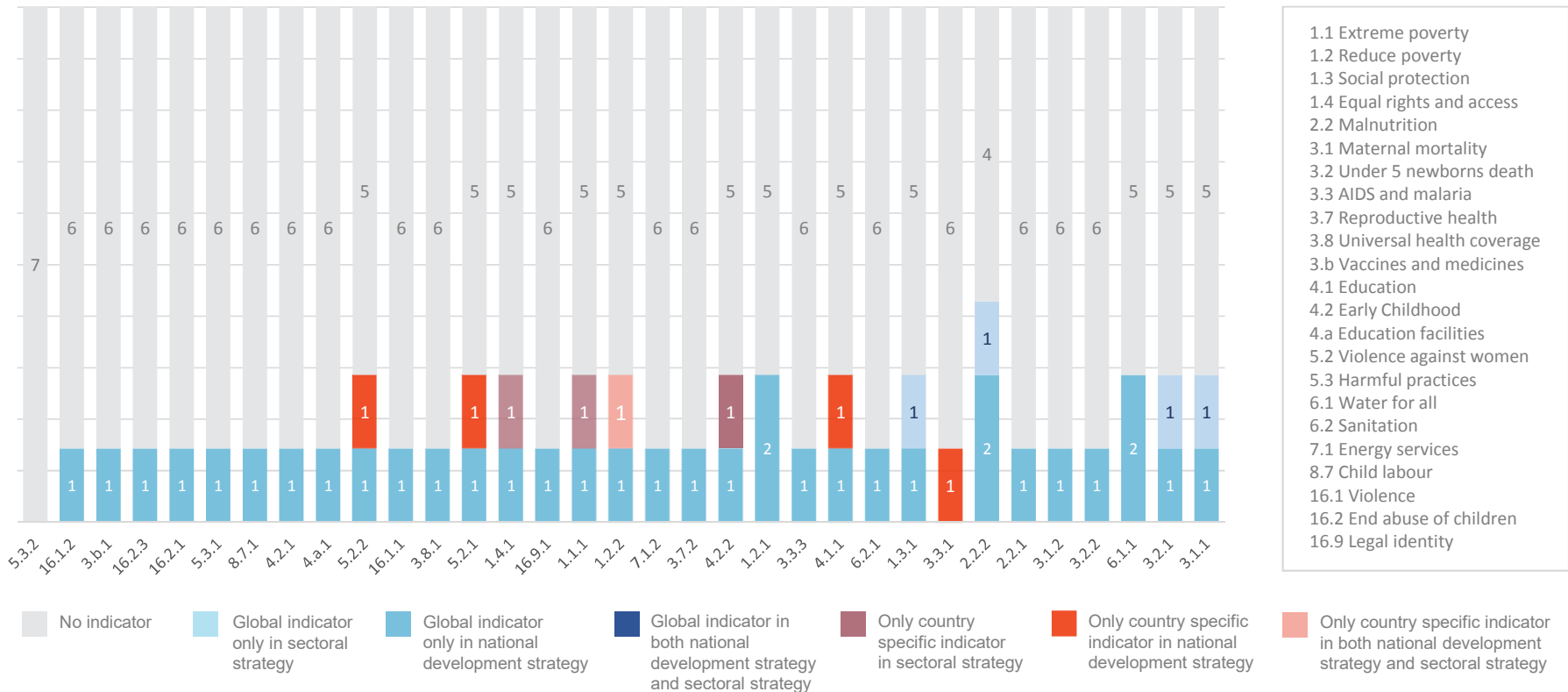

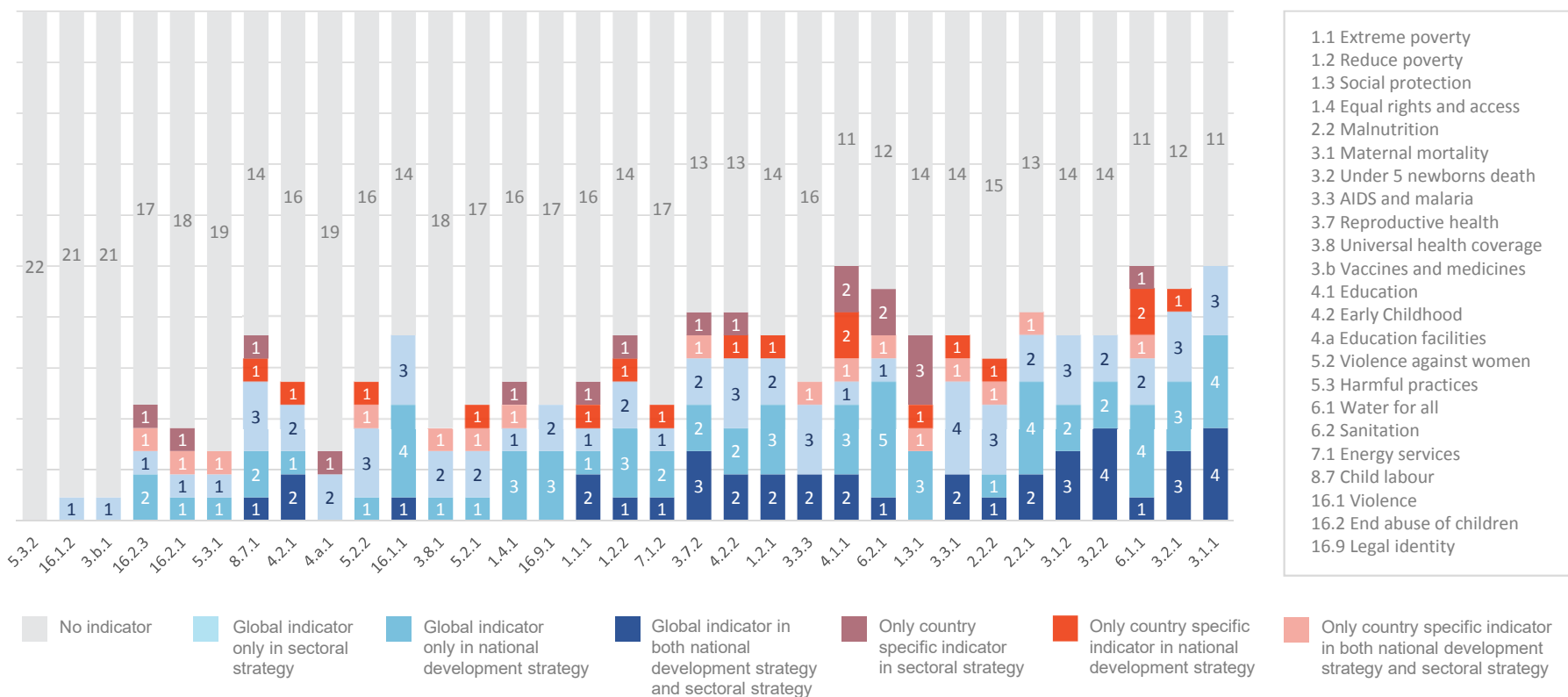

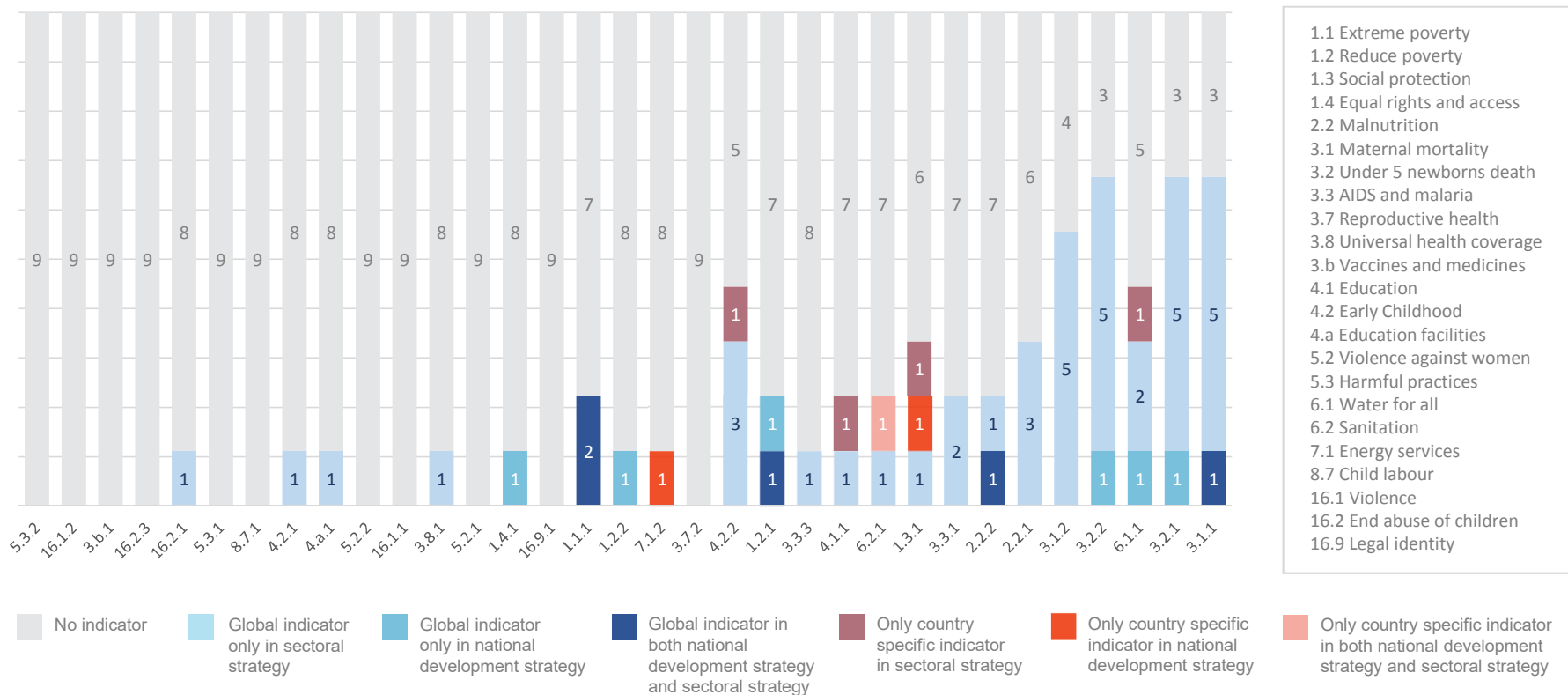

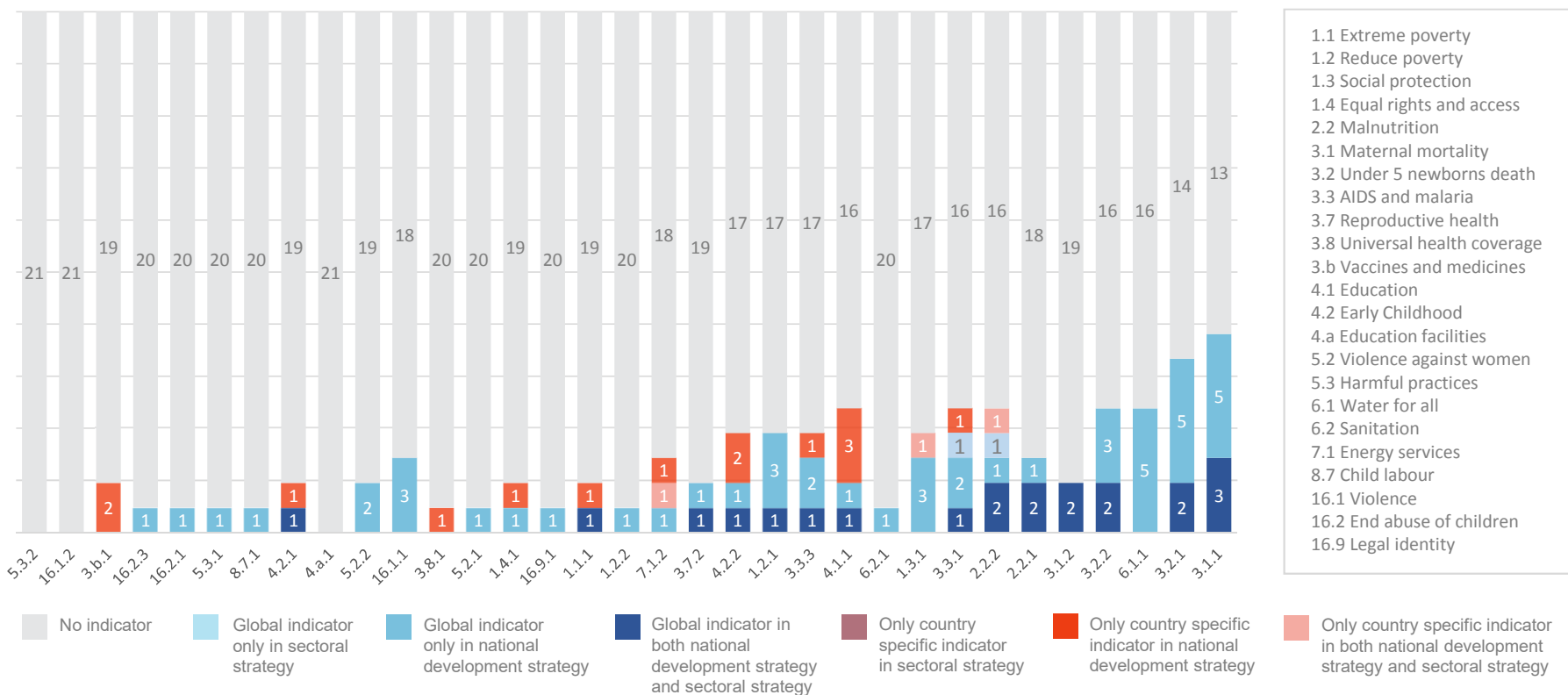
