

#### Main goals

- clarify and communicate role of statistics and NSOs in SDGs implementation
- explain complexities of reporting SDG indicators
- support countries in developing statistical capacity for SDG
- assist NSOs in effective communicating of SDG statistics

- bring together experience of various stakeholders, from global to sub-national level
- refer to works of different groups, including IAEG-SDG
- include many country case studies to illustrate practical examples
