

SDG 1.2.2: Proportion of men, women and children of all ages living in poverty in all its dimensions according to national definitions

- Custodians: National governments
 - Define and compute national official measure
 - Own and validate reported data
- Partner agencies: UNDP, UNICEF, World Bank
 - Support for country reporting: online system for data gathering
 - Technical support: capacity building, technical resources

Collected indicators

1) Official multidimensional poverty headcount (% of population)

- The percentage of people who are multidimensionally poor, further disaggregated by sex and age

2) Average number of deprivations (intensity)

- The average percentage of dimensions in which poor people are deprived


3) Official multidimensional poverty headcount (% of total households)

- The percentage of households who are multidimensionally poor

4) Child-specific multidimensional poverty

The percentage of children who are multidimensionally poor (measured at the individual child level)

Three stages of data collection and validation



Results of monitoring SDG 1.2.2



- The survey covered 189 countries across the world, and it was found that 77 countries have some kinds of multidimensional poverty measurement in the last 10 years
- Out of 77 countries, 63 countries have been confirmed by the NSO officers








Availability of multidimensional poverty data (Confirmed countries)
