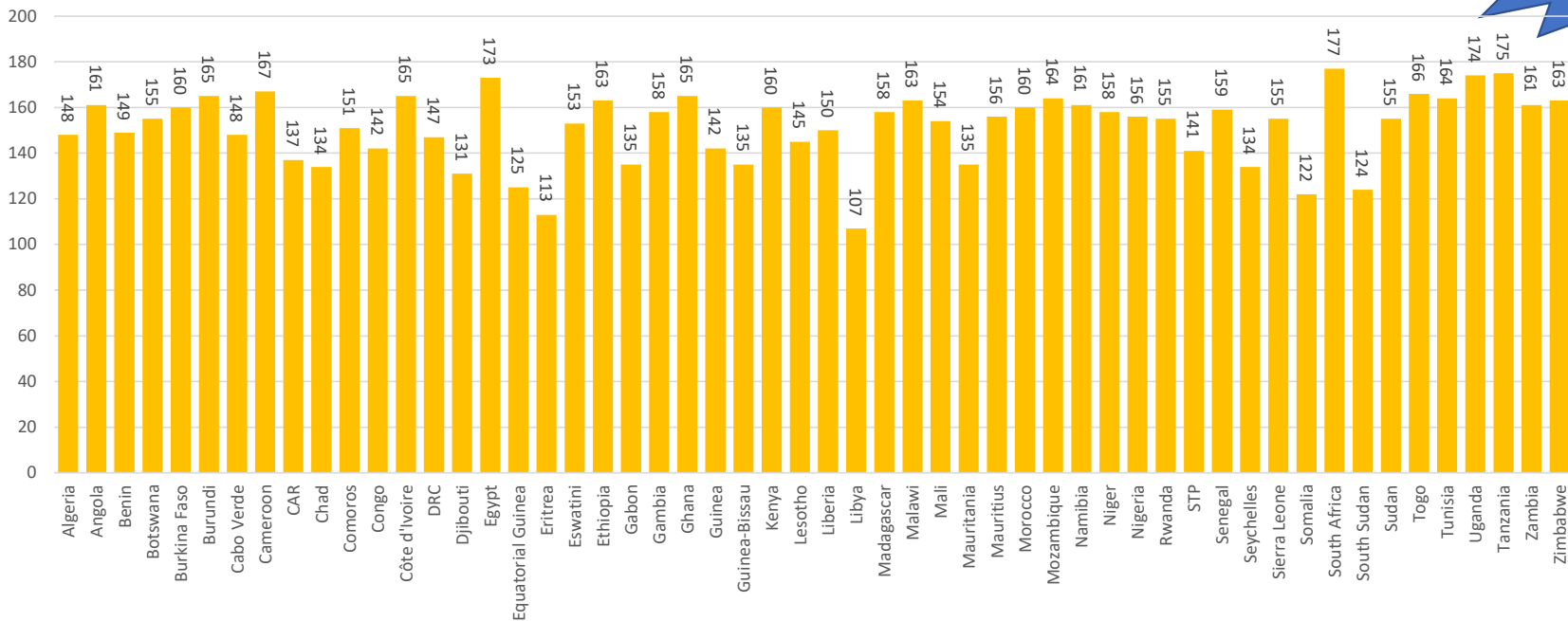

Data availability ranges from 103 to 177 indicators in African countries

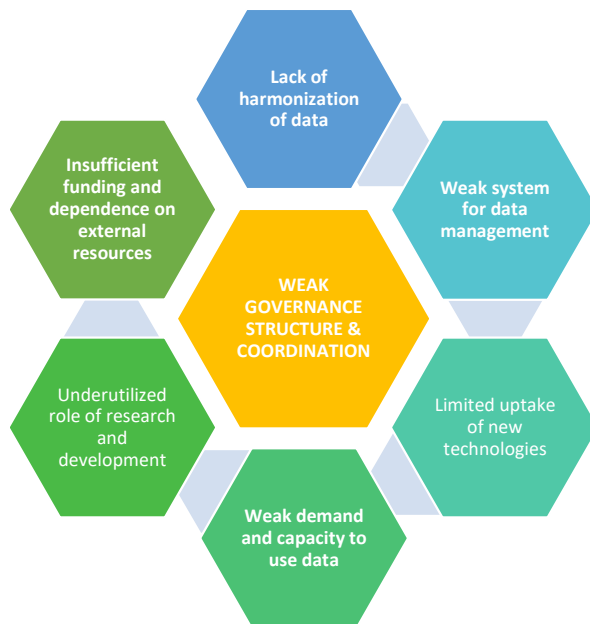

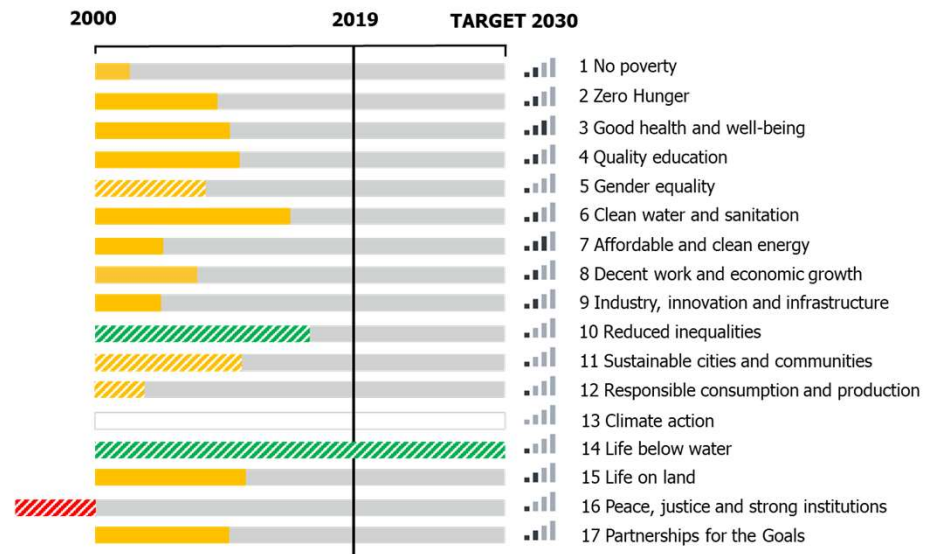
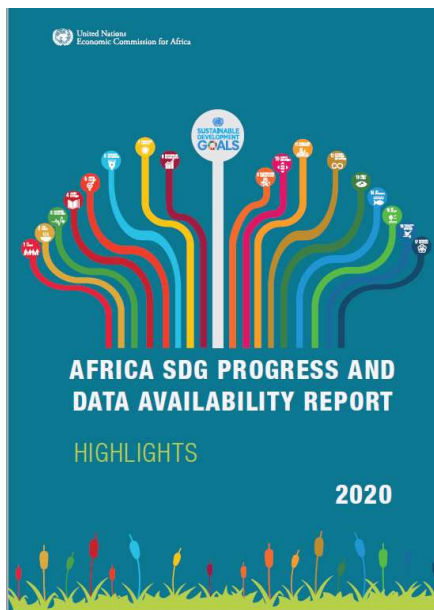
Partnerships & collaborations
