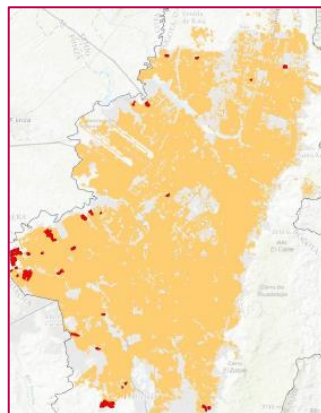
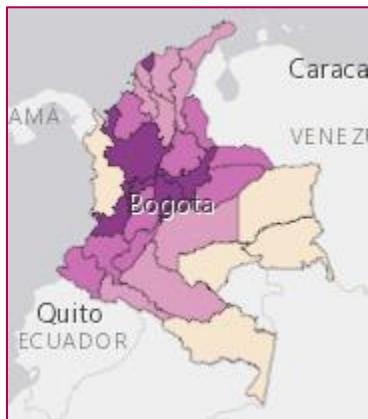
Currently Colombia fully supports and contributes to the activities of the IAEG-SDGs

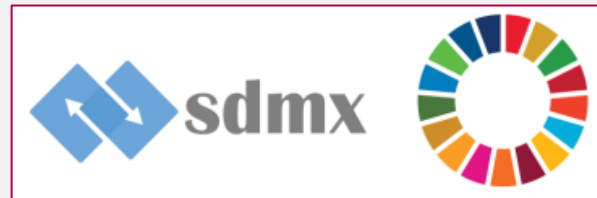
