

Sexual violence comprises any sexual activities imposed by an adult on a child against which the child is entitled to protection by criminal law.

This includes:

(a) The inducement or coercion of a child to engage in any unlawful or psychologically harmful sexual activity;

(b) The use of children in commercial sexual exploitation;

(c) The use of children in audio or visual images of child sexual abuse;

and (d) Child prostitution, sexual slavery, sexual exploitation in travel and tourism, trafficking for purposes of sexual exploitation (within and between countries), sale of children for sexual purposes and forced marriage.

Sexual activities are also considered as abuse when committed against a child by another child if the offender is significantly older than the victim or uses power, threat or other means of pressure.






MARS aims to improve data flow and management from administrative sources.


