

#### **Establishment of the Philippine SDG Indicator Focal Points (SDGI-FP)**

- Consists of permanent and alternate focal persons from 32 national government agencies
- The SDGI-FP plays a vital role in the methodological developments of SDG indicators and in the efficient updating of the **SDG Watch and Database**
- In addition, there is a team within the organization composed of 56 sector specialists and/or coordinators of the different interagency committees of PSA dealing with these agencies to facilitate the regular SDG monitoring.





