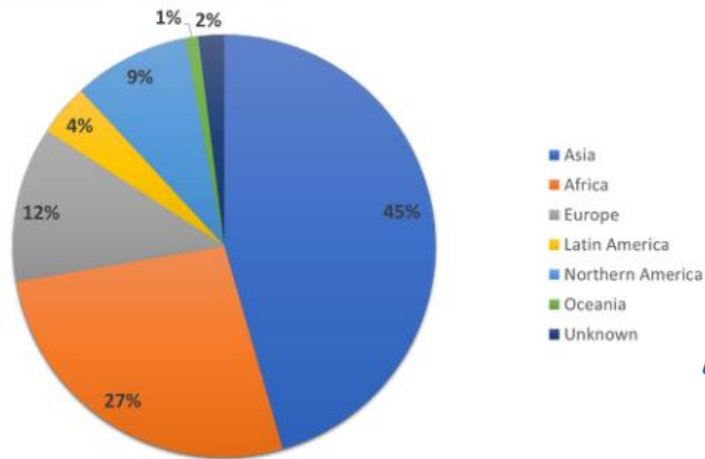

 - and much more

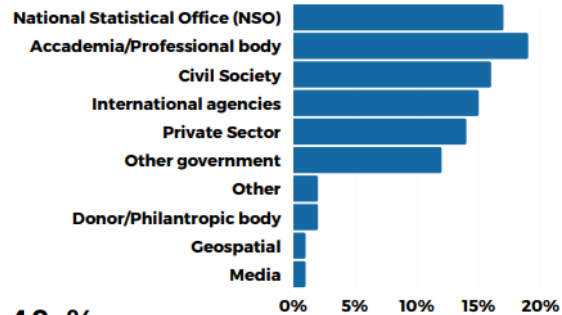
PARTICIPANTS BY REGION (%)

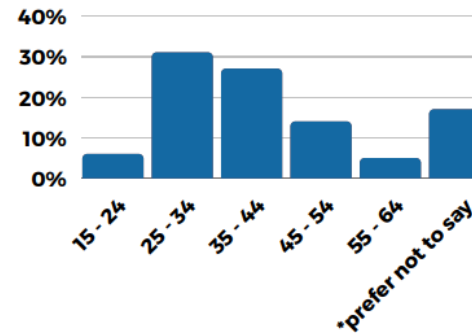

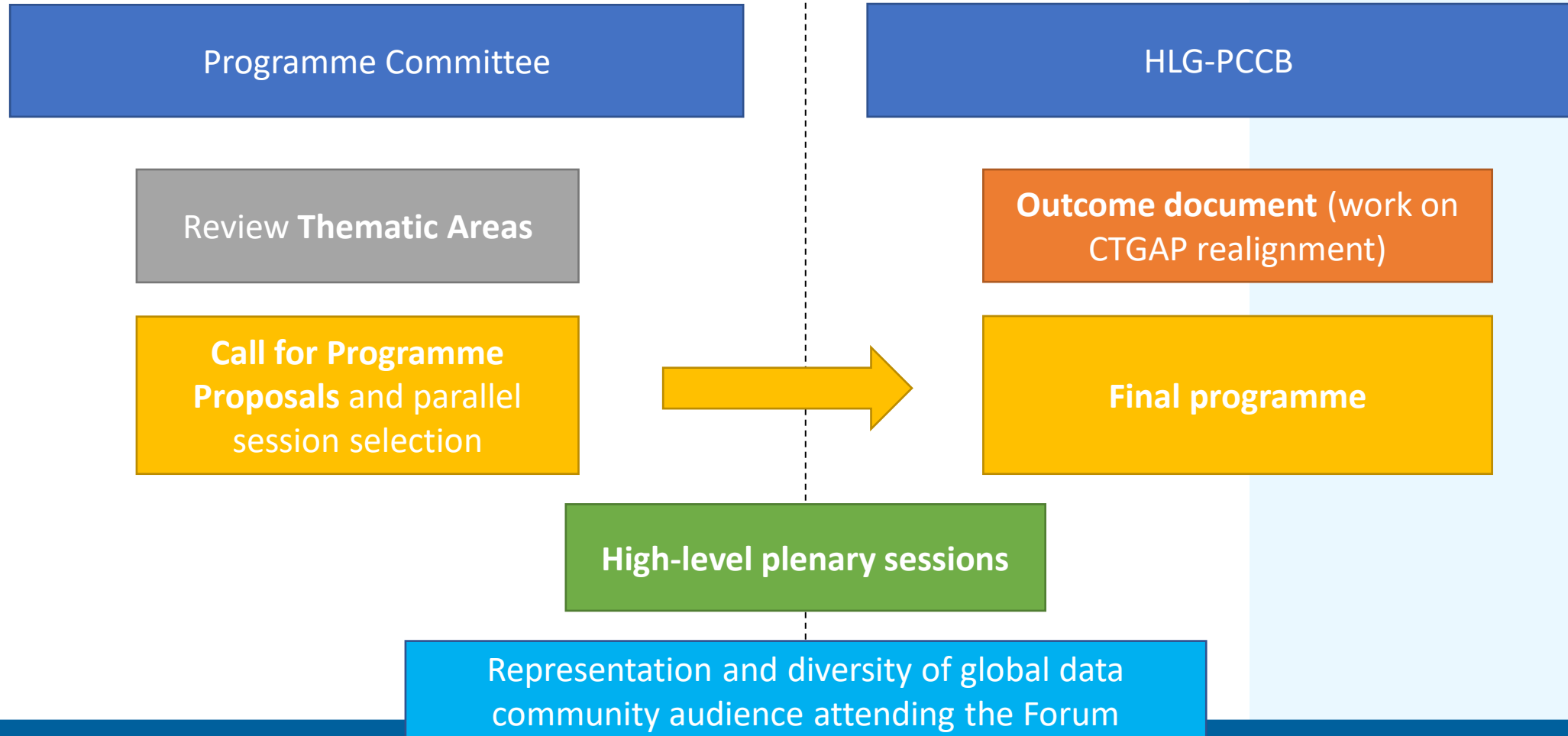

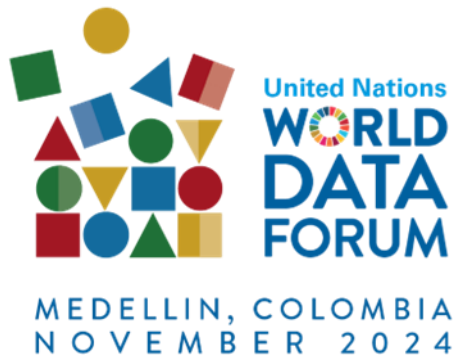
