Human Rights Data Partnerships

- **Consistent with SDG indicator 16.a.1:** Collaboration between NSO & NHRI
- **Complementary mandates:** shared objectives and challenges
- **Right to information:** ensuring people access to and trust in relevant statistics
- **Mutually strengthening approaches:** Fundamental Principles of Official Statistics & Human Rights Based-Approach to Data
- **Visibility of groups left behind:** identify, reach out and highlight groups marginalized in official statistics
- **SDG indicators:** populate indicators 16.10.1, 10.3.1/16.b.1, 16.1.2
- **Data quality:** participation of civil society
- **Common sense of purpose:** improve people's well being & enjoyment of human rights
