The areas featured within the realigned CTGAP 2.0 seek to categorize key statistical and data capacity building needs.	Priorities are the areas data and statistics spheres considered most important or urgent at a given moment. They are the objectives or activities that need to be addressed before others due to their relative importance, helping to establish the order in the task list and make decisions about what to do first and what to ignore or postpone.	Actions are the specific steps taken to complete a task, planned and executed based on established priorities. They are also the concrete stages undertaken on the path to completing a project or solving a problem, so each priority may require a series of actions to be completed.	Commitments are the obligations or responsibilities that a person or group assumes towards the actions aimed at the priorities.


