

Endorsed at the 55th session of the UN Statistical Commission, supporting interventions:

- 34 countries,
- 3 regional joint statements: Africa (voiced by Benin), European Statistical System incl. European Union and its Member States and EFTA countries (voiced by Finland), Gulf Cooperation Council (voiced by Saudi Arabia)
- ILO and the grouping of 40+ international organizations (incl. UN System)

Recognized by UN HLCP Core Group on Beyond GDP as first sectoral example of moving beyond GDP

Statistical Framework for Measuring the Sustainability of Tourism (SF-MST)


(endorsed by the UN Statistical Commission, 55th session, 1 March 2024)

Environmental: emissions, water, energy, waste, land **Social**: employment, decent work, education and skills, culture **Economic**: GDP, tourism establishments, seasonality
