#### Tier Classification Criteria/Definitions:

**Tier I:** Indicator is conceptually clear, has an internationally established methodology and standards are available, and data are regularly produced by countries for at least 50 per cent of countries and of the population in every region **where the indicator is relevant**.

**Tier II:** Indicator is conceptually clear, has an internationally established methodology and standards are available, but data are not regularly produced by countries.

### Tier II indicators that meet criteria and are approved for Tier I upgrade (3 unique indicators)
