Measuring South-South Cooperation

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➤ South-South Cooperation

- **South-South cooperation** is political, economic, social, cultural, environmental, and technical

Lacking systematic data

- ▶ Support for sustainable development not measured
- ▶ Hampers strategic management

Early data from pilots confirm **central role of non-financial** SSC flows

- Developing economies **seeking assistance to collect and report South-South data**

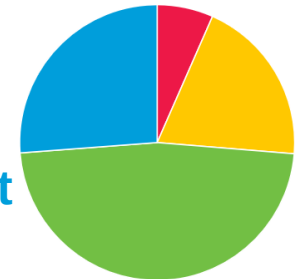

Concepts & Methods

- ▶ UNCTAD with UN Regional Commissions and other partners
- ▶ Experts ask for harmonized tools, analysis, reporting

75% countries interested to report data soon but need support



■ Longer term (after 5 years) (6.6%)
■ Medium term (3-5 years) (19.7%)
■ Near future (1-2 years) (47.5%)
■ Now, as soon as possible (26.2%)
