

Source data are taken from government finance statistics (GFS) database






GFS under an "Umbrella" of SNA


- The System of National Accounts (SNA):
 - the core statistical system
 - serving as an "umbrella" framework
 - providing definitions and concepts for all other macroeconomic statistics.
- GFS Manual 2014 is aligned with SNA 2008.
- GFS data are:
 - Standardized
 - Consistent
 - Comparable









SDG indicator production embedded in annual GFS production cycle





Challenges: Data Shortcomings (1) - Country Coverage

- Reporting countries: about 130 (out of 191 IMF member) countries annually *
 - varying depth and breadth of data
 - diverging by region notably Africa, South Asia/Middle East
 - declining in recent years
- Reporting agencies:
 - Ministries of Finance (for most countries)
 - Central Banks
 - National Statistics Offices

Challenges: Data Shortcomings (2)


- Institutional Sector Coverage

- GFS can be compiled for the Public Sector or its subsectors
 - For international comparisons, the GG sector is currently most important
 - Coverage more limited in some countries – CG or only BCG (notably low-income countries)
