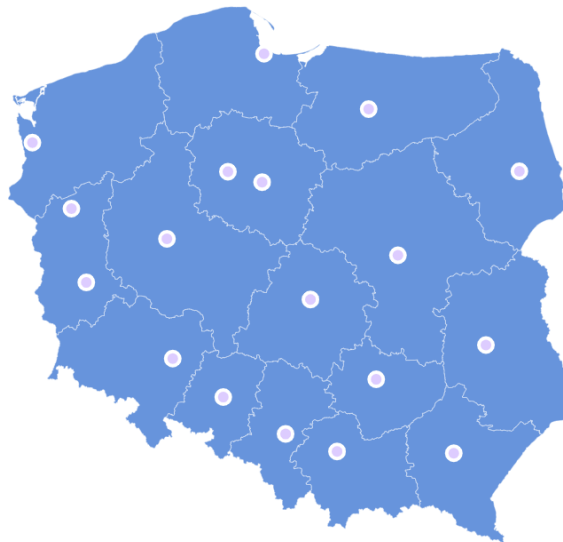

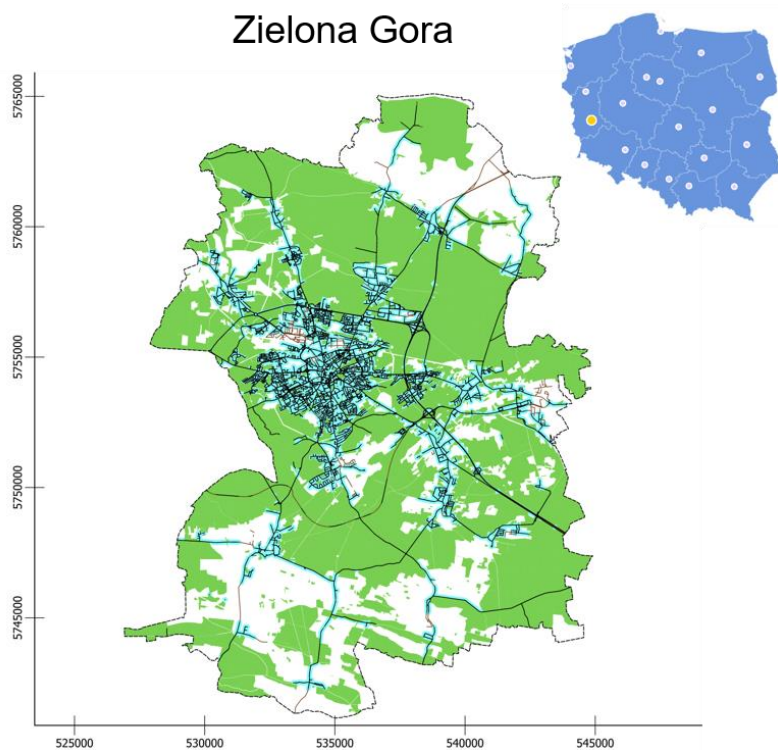

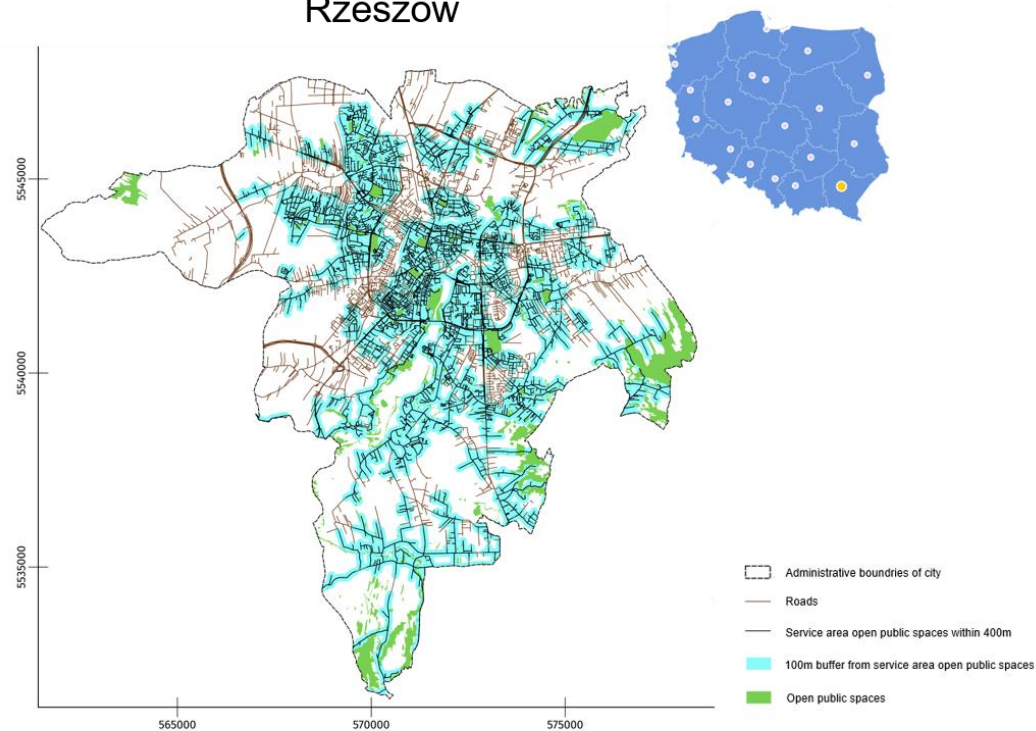


11.7.1 Average share of built-up area of cities that is open space for public use for all

Zielona Gora



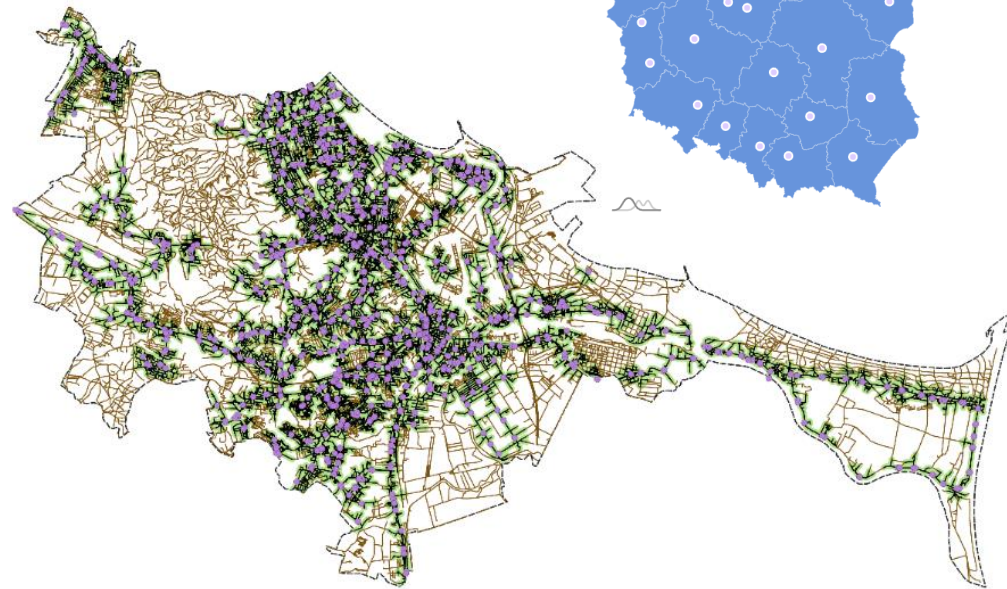
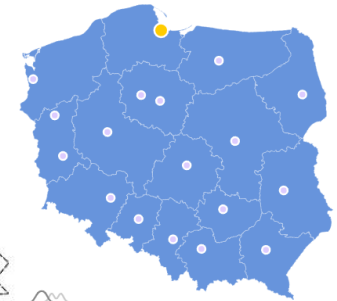
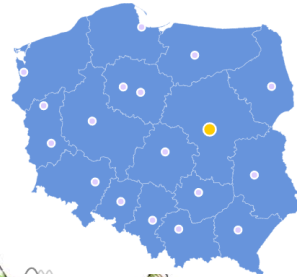
