1. <u>Data request</u>: FOCAL POINTS: Please submit county level, regional and global level data by 28 February 2017 to <u>sdgindicators@un.org</u>

2. <u>Time periods to be covered</u>:

- Data for global and regional aggregates should be provided for at least the following years (as much as possible): 2000, 2005, 2010, and the most recent year; receiving data for all years starting with the reporting 2000 would be welcome;
- Country data should be provided for all years starting with the reporting year 2000;

3. Regional groupings to be covered (see additional slide)

- Please use the newly established <u>SDG regional groupings</u> **AND** the previous <u>MDG regional</u> groupings for this year's data submission
- in addition, aggregates for Least Developed Countries (LDCs), Landlocked Developing Countries (LLDCs) and Small islands developing states (SIDS).



- 4. <u>Purpose</u>: Update of the global SDG indicator database; verification of the data submitted as part of the storylines; global and regional aggregates to be included in the online annex for the SG's progress report.
- 5. <u>Cut-off points</u> based on publication schedule and need to fully align results on the SDG database with data in two SDG reports and the accompanying online statistical annex:
 - 1 May for totals (SG's progress report)
 - **31 May** for regional aggregates (online Annex)
 - Data release: <u>17-19 July 2017</u> (loading of new and updated data currently expected to be *possible* until first week of July as long as not resulting in any discrepancies with already published data)

 - Currently, selection by specific indicator or specific country/area
 - In future, selection by parameters (INDICATOR(S), DATA SERIES, AREAS, YEARS)
 - Improvements in the presentation of the metadata
 - Many others



9. <u>Data availability 2016</u>:

- data for 115 of the 230 indicators; almost 500 data series and more than 330,000 data records
- The data series comprise Sustainable Development Goal indicators series (identified by the symbol "SD") and additional data series (identified by the symbol "+"); Many of the data series contain disaggregated data.
- For some of the 115 indicators included in the database, only additional data series
 (instead of Sustainable Development Goals data series) are available, which are used to
 provide data for closely related indicators. For 9 of the 115 global indicators, only
 regional and global aggregates are available.

10. Received so far for 2017 (as of 01/03/2017 9:00AM EST)

- Country and/or regional data: 98 Indicators
- Metadata: 16 Indicators (15 updates on existing metadata/1 for refined indicator)
- Additional metadata request (Google form): 10 Indicators

11. Future updates

- Data collection to be ongoing throughout the year
- Data release at specific intervals such as 2-4 times a year (to be discussed)
