

Annual Global Progress Reports on the Sustainable Development Goals

➢ GA resolution 70/1: "83. Follow-up and review at the high-level political forum will be informed by an annual progress report on the Sustainable Development Goals to be prepared by the Secretary-General in cooperation with the United Nations system, based on the global indicator framework and data produced by national statistical systems and information collected at the regional level"

➤ GA Resolution 70/299: "13. Reaffirms that the meetings of the high-level political forum will be informed by an annual progress report on the Sustainable Development Goals ..."



SDG Reports 2018

- Based on the global indicator framework, approved by the GA on 6 July 2017 (A/RES/71/313)
- Two reports
 - ✓ An official Secretary-General UN report covering all Goals
 - ✓ A glossy progress report based on HLPF theme & Goals under Review
- Translation into other 5 official languages



Objective & Scope of the 2018 SDG Reports

➤ Overarching theme of the 2018 SDG reports to be aligned with the 2018 theme of the HLPF

Transformation toward sustainable and resilient societies

> Scope:

- Secretary General's Report: Overview of all 17 Goals using data currently available to highlight the most significant gaps and challenges
- ➤ Glossy Report: Review in depth the Goals under HLPF Review: Goals 6, 7, 11, 12, 15, 17 and their interlinkages

- A/RES/70/299: Follow-up and review of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development at the global level



 - Statistical Annex (available separately online)
- Report progress on all 17 Goals



SDG Reports 2018: Secretary-General's Report

Format for inputs:

- Short summary description per indicator focusing on global summary.
- Report progress on all 17 Goals.
- These short summary descriptions will also be used in the Overview in the glossy report.

Example from Secretary-General's Report (2017)

Goal 7. Ensure access to affordable, reliable, sustainable and modern energy for all

- 11. Progress in every area of sustainable energy falls short of what is needed to achieve energy access for all and to meet targets for renewable energy and energy efficiency. Meaningful improvements will require higher levels of financing and bolder policy commitments, together with the willingness of countries to embrace new technologies on a much wider scale.
 - Globally, 85.3 per cent of the population had access to electricity in 2014, an increase of only 0.3 percentage points since 2012. That means that 1.06 billion people, predominantly rural dwellers, still function without electricity. Half of those people live in sub-Saharan Africa.
 - Access to clean fuels and technologies for cooking climbed to 57.4 per cent in 2014, up slightly from 56.5 per cent in 2012. More than 3 billion people, the majority of them in Asia and sub-Saharan Africa, are still cooking without clean fuels and more efficient technologies.
