

## Calculating regional aggregates

## A harmonized approach

To calculate aggregates similarly, we propose:

- Weighted averages: weights match source of data for relevant GDP & Population based indicators
  - Use GDP from UNSD
  - Use Population from Population Division
  - Use the same version of GDP and Population data
- 2. Agreement on how to treat Taiwan, and other territories during aggregation
- 3. Common criteria for when aggregate is computed versus when it is not
  - Our process requires that some (either interpolated or real) data must exist for 70% of countries/GDP - /Pop (whatever the weight is) with 30% of all countries having real data in order to aggregate for a particular region or economic grouping
  - Only interpolate/extrapolate for 5 years from the nearest real data point for the purpose of aggregating
