
#### Introduction

Education data collected once a year through decentralized levels:

- Review of data collection tools to meet data users needs (in specific variables were added for SDGs)
- Data collection tools downloadable on Ministry website
- Elaboration of Education statistical yearbook
  - Administrative data ----- Ministry of Education
  - Household surveys ------National institute of statistics

#### Leave no one behind

- Details oriented within the existing data
  - e.g. Pupil per classroom
  - Proportion of schools meeting standards pupils classrooms
- Details oriented requires specific field visit
  - e.g. Schools with access to basic drinking water: SDG4.a.1
  - number of tap water within the schools: access points

#### Specific program for specific targeted group

- Socio protection programs, introduction of nine year basic Education (Poor)
- Specific program to promote Gender equity (Female)
- Inclusive education (Disability)
- Integration of Refugees (Students, Teacher)




#### School data Management system



#### School data Management system

Unique identifier for schools, students and staff

Eg: Student Unique Identifier/ Student Serial Number a 21 digit sequence to represent a student



- Improve data quality: no duplicates
- School history: cohort
- Easy data disaggregation
- Monitoring and Evaluation
