GFS report is submitted annually to IMF. Compilation of data is centralised under MOF

MALAYSIA - PUBLIC ACCOUNTS

Custodian: The Accountant General Department of Malaysia under the Ministry of Finance

Compiled and reported yearly as the Federal Government Financial Statement

in accordance with the requirements of:

- Section 15 (1) of the Financial Procedure Act 1957 [Act 61]
- Government Accounting Standards (KDP 2: Presentation of Government Financial Statements)
- International Public Sector Accounting Standards (IPSAS)- Financial Reporting Under the Cash Basis of Accounting

Federal Government Financial Statement consists of Financial Status Statements, Cash Receipt and Payment Statements, Financial Performance as well as Notes to the Financial Statements.

Compiled by consolidating financial information from all accounting offices of the Accountant General Department and the ministries.

Accountant General Department as the coordinator across ministries and agencies.


MALAYSIA – COMPILATION OF GOVERNMENT EXPENDITURE ON AGRICULTURE (GEA)

Details programs and projects are available at ministries level.

Example of Ministries involve in agriculture:

- Ministry of Agriculture (MOA)
- Ministries of Plantations Industries and Commodities (MPIC)
- Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment (NRE)
- Ministry of Rural Development

Ministry of Finance (MOF) reports on the Federal Government's financial position which include revenue collection & expenditure performance




Compilation and dissemination of data: quarterly and annually

Four main sectors:

- Social;
- Economic;
- Security; and
- General Administration.

Agriculture is a subsector under the Economic sector

ISSUES AND CHALLENGES



Economic and functional classification of the expenditure are not fully based on GFS economic classification.



Data collected and produced are for Federal/Central Government only. Doesn't include the state and local government.



Have to strengthen the coordination among the government agencies.
