JORDAN

- Population = 9.5 million, including 2.9 million guests
- Economic growth = 7.7% per year (2004-2008)
- 60% population under the age of 25
- Number of students = 1,914,714
- Number of teachers = 110,523
- Number of schools = 7120
- The private sector accommodate more than 31.1%
- \$1 = 0.71 JOD

- Jordan's education system ranks number 1 in the Arab world and one of the highest in the developing world (UNESCO 2009, World Bank 2008)
- Jordan is a top performer in education among 14 MENA countries. (World Bank report, February 2008.)
- Jordan has the third lowest illiteracy rate in the Arab world (8.9%)
- The gross school enrolment ratio equal to 98.2% (UNESCO 2006)
- Transition ratio to secondary schools = 97% (UNESCO 2006) (Higher than region by 25%)

Jordanian Education System

- A 13Year comprehensive education program divided into two cycles
- 1- Elementary: runs from grades KG1 to 10
 Free and compulsory for all Jordanian
 2- Secondary: two year cycle divided into two main streams Academic and Vocational Grades 11 & 12

- Successful pilot in representative sample schools across 42 Field Directorates




KPI Framework

- Revised KPIs now allow MoE to comply with ERfKE donors conditionalities.
- Revised KPIs fully aligned with UNESCO international standards approved by UN statistical commission (NY).
- Responds to Monitoring needs of the MoE Plans and Strategies.
- 73 KPIs classified into 8 policy dimensions matching the new Sustainable Development Goals (SDG 4 Education).
- KPIs embedded into the OpenEMIS reporting tools.




What's New with OpenEMIS?

- Enhanced **Quality Control** over the data to ensure maximum accuracy.
- Full **ownership** of the MoE staff for further customization and maintenance
- Negligible early maintenance cost for the MoE (USD 25,000)
- Greater accessibility to data for Decision-Making at all levels:

 - Geographical Information System
 - Monitoring data collection campaigns

The system has been disseminated all 42 directorates ,and all schools where instructed to enter information on this system.

After conducting all amendments by the team of experts

Pilot phase started on 63 schools

A core team was trained on how to handle this system

OpenEMIS was introduced in its first version in March of 2016



by Geographic Area













