- The most important is raising awareness towards SDGs inside PCBS, and on the national levels (governmental, public sectors, private sectors, civil society, and research centers).

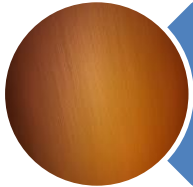
