Based on UNSC <u>Decision 53/102</u>, the IAEG-SDG work plan 2022-2023 will focus on:

Areas of Work

A. Indicator framework implementation:

- update good practices on SDG monitoring website, including collecting good practices on data innovation from countries;
- share capacity building needs already identified with HLG and CCSA;
- liaise with the HLG on activities on financial support for SDG monitoring to expand dialogue;
- develop questionnaire to compile capacity building and training programmes on SDG monitoring and develop an online platform of these materials (from custodian agencies, RCs, etc.).
- **B.** Methodological development/metadata review:
 - continue review of any updated metadata with significant change(s) in methodology;
 - metadata sub-group continues reviews of metadata to improve quality;
 - Iiaise with custodians on E-handbook.

Based on UNSC <u>Decision 53/102</u>, the IAEG-SDG work plan 2022-2023 will focus on: *Areas of Work*

- C. Data Disaggregation and Small Area Estimation:
 - update data disaggregation good practices on wiki platform;
 - continue SAE for SDGs support to countries via e-learning and capacity building;
 - Working Group on Geospatial Information task team on data disaggregation to inform and engage with Group.
- **D. IAEG-SDG Working Groups:**
 - review working group workplans for additional activities;
 - working groups (Geospatial and SDMX) to carry out work programmes and update Group.
- E. Dialogue with custodians/data flows:
 - IAEG-SDG co-chairs to meet regularly with CCSA/CCS-UN co-chairs to discuss issues raised by countries;
 - bilateral meetings with custodians as needed.

Based on UNSC **Decision 53/102**, the IAEG-SDG work plan 2022-2023 will focus on:

Areas of Work

- F. Meetings/Working Modalities:
 - IAEG to hold monthly meetings;
 - Periodic open meetings;
 - 13th meeting in Oct/Nov (possibly a physical meeting).
- E. Specific Indicator issues:
 - Target 8.9: IAEG-SDG to develop a task team for the development of methodologies for indicators on sustainable tourism to ensure they are ready for submission for the 2025 comprehensive review;
 - Indicator 17.3.1: UNCTAD to lead further work on South-South cooperation conceptual framework and report to IAEG on progress; UNSD to support countries on further review and include update to UNSC54.
