1) Official multidimensional poverty headcount (% of population)

- The percentage of people who are multidimensionally poor, further disaggregated by sex and age

2) Average number of deprivations (intensity)

- The average percentage of dimensions in which poor people are deprived

3) Official multidimensional poverty headcount (% of total households)

- The percentage of households who are multidimensionally poor

4) Child-specific multidimensional poverty

- The percentage of children who are multidimensionally poor (measured at the individual child level)

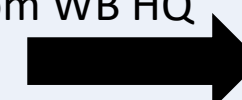

Results of monitoring SDG 1.2.2



- The survey covered **189** countries across the world, and it was found that **76** countries have some kinds of multidimensional poverty measurement in the last 10 years
- Out of 76 countries, **47** countries have been confirmed by the NSO officers
