Compilation of existing tools and resources for data disaggregation

- Since 2015, the Inter-Agency and Expert Group on SDG Indicators (IAEG-SDGs), tasked to develop and implement the global indicator framework for the Goals and targets of the 2030 Agenda, has included work on data disaggregation in its annual activities.¹
- The IAEG-SDGs developed a stock-taking questionnaire to identify existing methodologies, guidelines and tools specific for data disaggregation that have already been developed and agreed by key expert/international groups, mechanisms and committees.
- The participants included established city and expert groups under the UNSC, international expert groups and committees, as well as UN agencies and stakeholders focusing on vulnerable populations, disaggregation dimensions and data collection methods (i.e. household surveys, etc.).
