

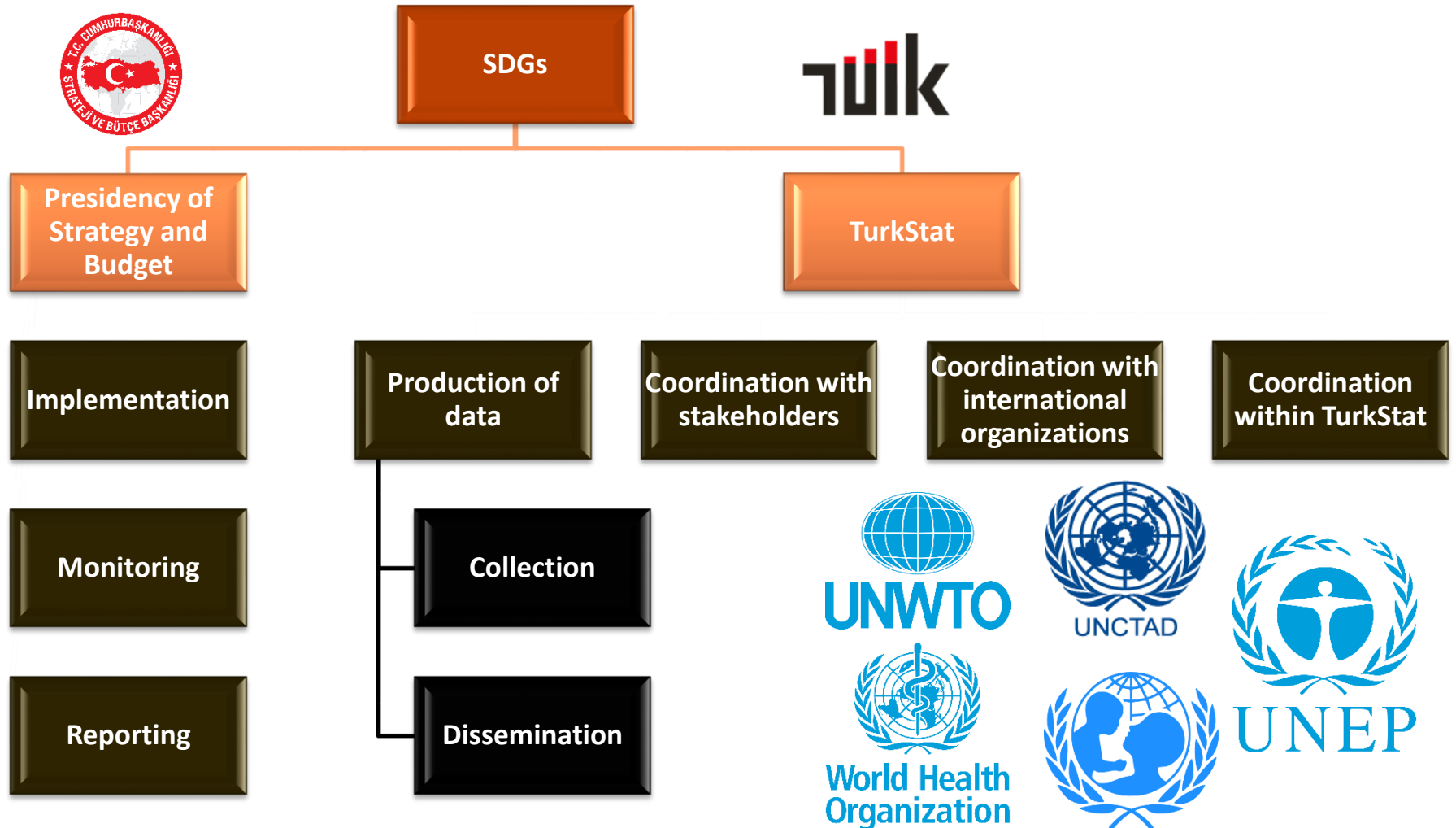

TurkStat approach to reporting SDG data

- Report all global indicators
 - Include statistical and non-statistical
 - A few non-relevant indicators
- Disaggregation is crucial
- Openness and transparency
- Ensure open access to data for the public
- Give significant attention to comprehensive metadata
 - National & global metadata available
- Implement a design that prioritizes the needs of users

TurkStat approach to improve collaborations for complete data collection

- Official Statistical Programme
 - Identification of responsible parties
 - Defining duties and division of labour
 - Keeping the info uptodate with regular and frequent working group meetings
- Increased use of administrative data
- Employ alternative techniques, e.g. GIS
- Collaborating with international organizations for appropriate methodologies

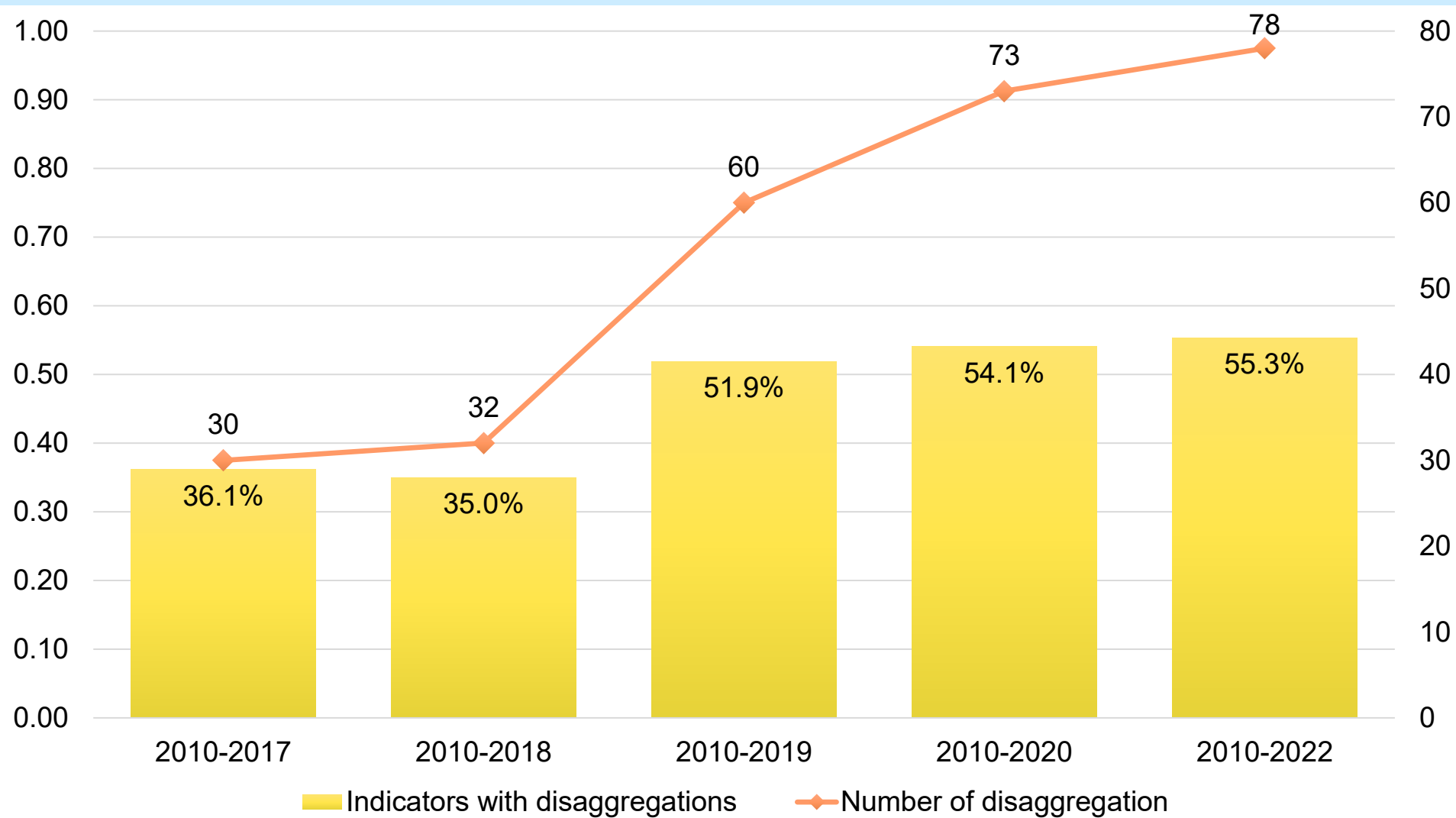
Overall reporting status



Status by goal



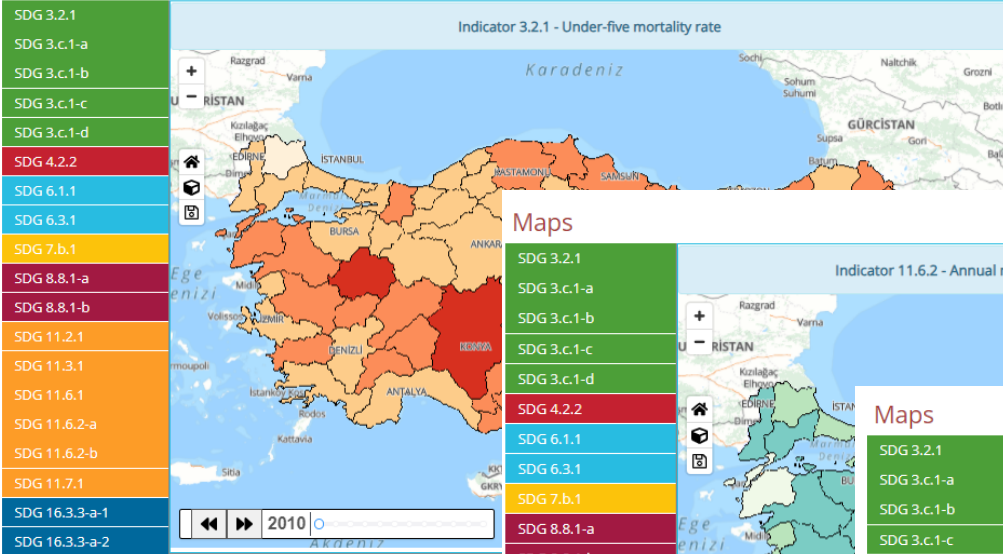

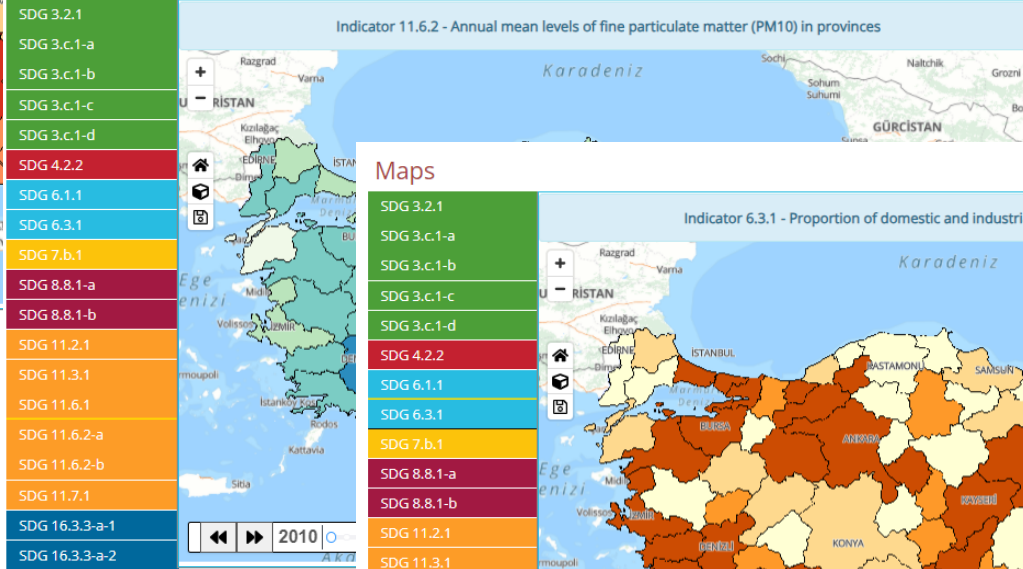

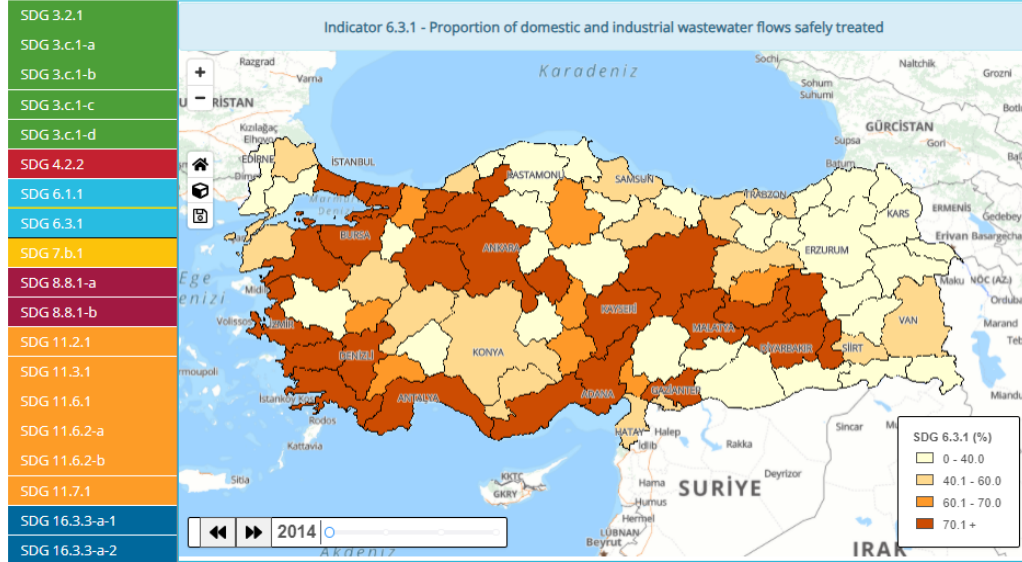
