






STATE OF SDGS DATA IN AFRICA: # of INDICATORS WITH AT LEAST ONE DATA POINT




STATE OF SDGS DATA IN AFRICA: DISAGGREGATION / SERIES




STATE OF SDGS DATA IN AFRICA: Data availability (at least three-year data)



Assessing Progress in SDGs: Where We Stand Today



Africa is progressing in 13 of the 17 SDGs, the current rate of progress is not adequate to meet the targets by 2030.



Goals 2 and 3 are relatively higher levels of progress compared to the other SDGs.



The progress towards the SDGs differs across various countries and sub-regions, with Southern and Eastern Africa showing relatively better performance compared to other ECA sub-regions.




Morocco, Mauritius, Rwanda, Seychelles and Guinea-Bissau are the top five performers, whereas Sierra Leone, Angola, Sudan, Chad and Equatorial Guinea are the lowest performers on the continent.



The Regional Hub for Big Data and Data Science in Africa is a partnership between the United Nations Economic Commission for Africa, the National Institute of Statistics of Rwanda and the UN Department of Economic and Social Affairs to facilitate cross-border collaboration projects that apply big data and data science to complement official statistics, provide knowledge on newly developed methods, algorithms, and tools, and offer training in the use of big data and data science for the community of official statisticians in Africa.

The Africa Natural Capital Accounting Community of Practice (NCA-CoP) is a regional learning and knowledge exchange platform dedicated to fostering the compilation of environmental-economic and ecosystems accounts in support to the design, implementation and evaluation of environmentally-friendly policies for a sustainable development in Africa.

Agriculture & Beyond Global Strategy to improve Agricultural and Rural Statistics - GSARS


The initiative to develop the Global Strategy to improve agricultural and rural statistics (GSARS) came as a response to address developing countries' lack of capacity to provide reliable statistical data on food and agriculture and to provide a blueprint for long-term sustainable agricultural statistical systems. The Global Strategy is a comprehensive framework for improving the availability and use of agricultural and rural data, necessary for evidence-based decision making.
