# OTHER ISSUES CONCERNING DIGITAL DATA FROM NATURAL RESOURCES CANADA

### Copyright issues concerning digital data

The Centre for Topographic Information (CTI) of Natural Resources Canada data is protected under the Copyright Act (Canada) and International Conventions. Written permission is required before CTI data can be reproduced.

Under the Copyright Act, copyright will be infringed if CTI data are reproduced in whole or in part, by any means, e.g., graphically, electronically, or mechanically, without the written permission of CTI.

You will need permission in writing, either a license or a permission letter, before any data may be:

- used or copied for teaching and exposing;
- reproduced;
- transmitted in any form, or viewed and transmitted by any means, e.g., being viewed on a computer terminal;
- translated into another form (for example, hard copy) or another language;
- stored in a retrieval system; or,
- transmitted in any form, or by any means, whether electronic, mechanical, photocopying, tracing, recording, and so on.

# Information required for permission to reproduce CTI Data

An application for permission to reproduce or copy CTI data <u>must</u> contain the following information:

- the applicant's name;
- clearly identify the original map, data set, aerial photograph, or other material that the applicant would like to reproduce;
- state the applicant's intended use of the material, including a description of the proposed product and describe in detail the amount of the original CTI product to be reproduced;
- state the recommended price or fee applicable for the product to be produced by the applicant where applicable:
- state the intended number of copies of the product to be produced;
- state the proportion of the product devoted to CTI material; and
- describe the proposed scope of the use, sale, and/or distribution of the product.

### Royalties

A royalty is a fee paid to Natural Resources Canada in respect of use of its data.

### Acknowledgement

Every reproduction must carry an acknowledgement, the usual form of which will be: "Topographic Mapping Products produced under licence from Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Canada, with permission of Natural Resources Canada."

### Multiple site licenses

A multiple site license is a legal agreement between the client and Natural Resources Canada (NRCan), through Geomatics Canada. The client is licensed the right to use the data for its own internal use and is subject to terms and conditions set by NRCan. The data is licensed, not sold, to the client and is protected under the Copyright Act (Canada) and belongs to Geomatics Canada. The client cannot sell, loan, lease, distribute, transfer, or sublicense the data under this agreement to any third party without prior written consent of Geomatics Canada. As well, the use of the data or additional sites are subject to data set actual purchase price per additional site.

### Subscription agreements

This is a legal agreement between the subscriber and Natural Resources Canada (NRCan). The subscriber acknowledges that the data received are protected under the Copyright Act of Canada and belongs to NRCan. The subscriber cannot sell, loan, or transfer information acquired from the CGNDB under this agreement to any third party without prior permission of NRCan. If the subscriber wishes to produce a product for retailing or other purposes using CGNDB data, a licensing agreement will be required and may be negotiated with NRCan to authorize the development and/or sale of such product.
