## SINGLE ROMANIZATION SYSTEM FOR EACH NON-ROMAN WRITING SYSTEM

## <u>Draft resolution submitted by India</u>

The Conference,

Noting that no progress in preparing a single romanization system for a number of important languages has yet been made since the Second Conference,

Noting further that this state of affairs is due mainly to the fact that countries in which these languages are spoken have not yet taken part in the sessions of the United Nations Group of Experts on Geographical Names and the United Nations Conferences on Geographical Names.

 $\underline{\text{Recognizing}}$  the desirability of preparing a romanization system for these languages,

Recommends that the United Nations Group of Experts on Geographical Names take up this matter.
