Summary***

The fourth revised version of the toponymic guidelines for map editors and other editors, Finland, presented at the twenty-second session of the United Nations Group of Experts on Geographical Names in New York, 2004, has now been updated (version 4.3, 11 May 2007).

The updated version contains, inter alia, the most recent data on the distribution of population and languages in Finland and a list of updated publications as well as the number of municipalities and their linguistic distribution as at the beginning of 2007.

The list of the names of Finnish municipalities has been updated according to the situation at the beginning of 2007.
