

INTRODUCTION



Established in 1949 as Bureau of Statistics

Department of Statistics, Malaysia (DOSM) is the premier government agency entrusted with the responsibility for the purpose of monitoring national economic performance and social development of the country.



ROLE:

To increase and broaden its in the field of statistics towards establishing a quality, user-oriented and timely information system for national development planning and administration.

Operate under the Statistics Act 1965 (Revised 1989)





NATIONAL TRANSFORMATION PROGRAMME (NTP)

MALAYSIA National Transformation Programme (NTP)

- an ambitious, multi-lateral plan of change that aims to propel the country into a developed, high-income nation by 2020 (GNI per capita USD15,000)
- Divided into 2 components:
- i. Government Transformation Programme (GTP)
 - aims to transform the Malaysian civil service into a dynamic, innovative & people-focused administration through the 7 National Key Results Areas (NKRAS)
