Question 7 – For a person who has learned two languages at the same time in early childhood, report the language this person spoke most often at home before starting school. Report two languages only if they were used equally often and are still understood by this person.

For a child who has not yet learned to speak, report the language spoken most often to this child at home. Report two languages only if they are spoken equally often so that the child learns both languages at the same time.



Reasons why we ask the questions



Questions 2 to 6 provide information that is used for planning social programs, such as Old Age Security and the Child Tax Benefit. It is also used by towns and cities to plan a variety of services such as day-care centres, schools and senior citizens' homes.

Question 7 asks for the language first learned at home in childhood and still understood. These data are used to establish the size of the various language groups. This information is used to implement programs that protect the rights of Canadians under the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms. It also helps to determine the need for language training and services in English or French.

The law protects what you tell us

The confidentiality of your census questionnaire is protected by law. All Statistics Canada employees have taken an oath of secrecy. Your personal information cannot be given to anyone outside Statistics Canada — not the police, not another government department, not another person. This is your right.

Your census questionnaire will be retained in accordance with legislative requirements and will be stored securely. You can ask to see the information you gave about yourself on your 2001 Census questionnaire after November 2001. To do this, write to the Privacy Coordinator, Statistics Canada, 25th Floor, R.H.
