Why a Population Census?

Virtually all countries conduct Population Censuses at regular intervals. It is impossible to govern a country without knowing the main characteristics of its individual components, so the data generated by the Population Census - for instance, about the movement of the Swiss and foreign population, mobility within the country, training, language or the structure of families and housing are indispensable. The Census provides crucial information for policy decisions on employment, health, social insurance, transport and even housing.

Switzerland has been conducting population censuses since 1850, making it possible to trace developments over this period and to compare them with the situation in other countries. The Population Census is therefore a fundamental part of our national heritage and collective knowledge.

- Who is contampled.

- It is mandatory for everybody residing in Switzerland at the time of the Population Census to answer the questions for themselves and for those they legally represent, for example their children.
- It is also mandatory for people who are temporarily absent on Census day (5 December 2000) to provide the information requested.
- People with more than one domicile must complete a personal questionnaire for each domicile.

 Anybody intentionally providing false or incomplete answers or who fails to return the questionnaires by the deadline despite a reminder will have to pay his/her commune a fee for the extra work caused.

• All your replies are treated confidentially and are intended for the Swiss

- Federal Statistical Office. The only exception is the data on the first page of the personal questionnaire which may be used by your commune to verify the correctness of the data on its population register.
- Personal information, such as your name, address and telephone number, is destroyed as soon as quality control work on the questionnaires is completed. Destruction of this information is duly supervised by the appropriate data protection bodies.
- All persons involved in the Population Census are bound by professional secrecy under pain of legal sanctions. All Census operations are monitored by the federal and cantonal data protection authorities.
- The general public has access to the Population Census results.

Correct completion of the questionnaires saves your commune from having to carry out costly follow-up investigations, so please do not hesitate to co-sect us for any further information. Thank you for helping to make the Population Census 2000 a success.
