**STATEC**

In accordance with the provisions of Article 18 of the law of 31 March 1979 on the use of personal data in data processing, we wish to inform respondents of the following facts

**QUESTION IS THIS DWELLING YOUR NORMAL PLACE OF RESIDENCE?**

**NORMAL PLACE OF RESIDENCE**

The normal place of residence is the place where various persons forming a household live together or the place where a single person forming a household by himself/herself usually lives. The address of this place is usually the address under which the person is registered with their commune

**Note 2**
