Dear inhabitants.

in most of the countries all over the world the Population and Housing Census is conducted. International organizations as well as individual countries consider the Census as very important. For the Slovak Republic it is more significant, while it is the first Census in the independent Slovak Republic.

This statistical action will enable to obtain new information for knowing socio-economic and demographic development of our society and at the same time a database for the prediction of the economic and social development in future will be gained.

Census in the Slovak Republic will be conducted according to the Act on Population and Housing Census 2001 n° 165/1998. The decisive moment of the Census is midnight from Friday 25th May to Saturday 26th May 2001. Enumeration period was stated by government of the Slovak Republic for the period of 19th May - 10th June 2001. At this time the enumerator will visit you and he will ask you to fill in the Census forms

In order of ensuring the objective results of the Census we would like to ask you for complete, correct and true filling in the Census forms according to explanation and passing them to enumerator in the term agreed upon. The obligation of filling in the Census forms is stipulated in § 4 sec. I of the Act on Population and Housing Census 2001 nº 165/1998.

Individual data are protected by Law and will be used strictly for the needs of the Statistical Office of the Slovak Republic.

Thank you for providing the data and looking forward to the further collaboration.

GENERAL EXPLANATIONS

1. PERSONAL FORM

Personal Form is to be filled in by every person having at the decisive moment of the Census permanent residence on the territory of the Slovak Republic or is temporarily present. Every person fills in the Personal Form himself. For dependent children the Personal Form is to be filled in by one of the parents or other legal representative, for the disabled person by a guardian or the enumerator if being asked for. For the person permanently living in a dwelling but temporarily absent, the form will be filled in by other person from the household. For the persons died before midnight May 25th to May 26th and for children born after this midnight, the personal form will not be filled in. The Personal Form is to be filled also by foreigners (except of persons with diplomatic immunity) staying on the territory of the Slovak Republic less than 30 days. They will fill in the questions 3, 4, 9, 22, and 23 of the Personal Form.

Column b contains name and surname of all persons present in a dwelling, column c contains the relationship to the user of dwelling. column d contains the code of the relationship to the user of dwelling.

Relationship to the user of dwelling: user husband, wife, mate, son, daughter, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, grandchild, great-grandchild. parent, grandparent, parent-in-law, other relative, lodger, other person.

EXPLANATIONS FOR FILLING IN THE PERSONAL FORM

1. Type of residence

<u>permanent - present</u>

To be filled in by persons present at the place of permanent residence at the decisive moment of the Census and by persons e.g. at night shift, at transport means, or being absent for a short time

permanent - temporarily absent

To be filled in by persons absent from their place of permanent residence at the decisive moment of the Census. The reason of temporary absence can be employment, study, holiday, treatment, visit, etc. As temporary absent are considered also persons at military service, children at infant institutions, at child homes, etc.

temporary

To be filled in by persons present at other address as their permanent residence. These persons should fill in also the questions 22 and 23.

8. Number of live-born children

To be filled in only by women. Number of all live-born children until Census date should be written. Women without children should write zero.

9. Citizenship

Children up to 15 have the citizenship of their parents. In the case of different citizenship, children are given the citizenship based on the mutual decision of the parents.

10. Nationality

Nationality means belonging to nation, national or ethnic minority. For nationality determination mother tongue or the language usually used or better known by the person is not crucial, but the own decision.

Nationality of children up to 15 will be given by the parents. In the case the parents have different nationality, it will be given according to one of them (their mutual decision).

In the alternative other write down, the concrete nationality.

11. Mother language

In the case the parents have different language, write down the language spoken by mother. Mother language can be different from the nationality.

In the alternative other write down—the concrete mother language.

12. Religion/church

Religion means participation of the person in the religious life of any church or relation to the church. Children up to 15 will be given the religion according to the decision of parents. In the alternative *other* write down the concrete religion.

13. Educational attainment - name of the school

Highest educational attainment should be filled in. Write down the name of the school at the time of finishing the studies.

The name of the school should not be filled in by children up to 16, by persons with elementary education and by persons without education

<u>elementary</u>

To be filled in also by students of 8-year high schools, or 8-year conservatoires in the case they have finished the first four years of that high school (conservatoire).

To be filled in also by persons with incomplete elementary education, i. e. persons who finished the compulsory schooling without completing all grades and they are older than 16.

university doctorand

To be filled in by graduates of the former scientific training or the current doctorand program.

14. Economic activity

Economic activity is an information on economic status of the person on the labor market at the decisive moment of the Census.

Economically active population comprises persons being at the decisive moment of the Census in work, in membership, in duty or in similar relation to any organization, to cooperative, to private person or to other legal subject, employers, helpers, unemployed, self-employed, irrespectively of time usually worked.

working.

Comprises persons 16-years and older in paid job and also helping household members in a family enterprises. Also persons at military service, persons in a prison if their work relation still exists. Comprises also entrepreneurs with or without employees.

Working pensioners are not included.

apprentice

Comprises persons learning on daily base at apprenticeship institution.

secondary school student

Comprises persons studying on daily base at high school.

university student

Comprises persons studying on daily base at the university.

person on maternity leave (incl. further maternity leave)

Comprises persons on maternity (parental) leave if their work relation still exists.

homekeeping

Comprises persons 16-years and older dependent by the livelihood on another household member and persons out of the working relation. These are for example persons carring for a child, external university students, unemployed graduates of universities.

pensioner

Comprises all pensioners (working and non-working)

<u>unemployed</u>

Comprises all persons 16-years and older without a job actively seeking work

other

Comprises persons who are not dependent by the livelihood on another household member, do not have an income from employment and have another financial sources of livelihood. Also persons at military service, persons in a prison without existing work relation.

15. Social group

To be filled in by the category working and by working pensioners according to the current job.

Non-working pensioners, unemployed, persons at military service, persons in a prison, persons on maternity (parental) leave according to the last job.

Should not be filled in by children up to 16, apprentices, secondary school students and university students.

employee working for wage, salary, other kind of remuneration

Comprises persons with the work relation for certain as well as for uncertain time, employees appointed or voted in service relation (i.e. armed forces, police, including persons at military service). Also persons employed on the base of agreement upon working activity and of agreement upon carrying out a work.

member of production cooperative

Comprises the members of production, agricultural or other production cooperatives. Employees of these cooperatives and members of consumer cooperatives.

entrepreneur (partner, tradesman) with employees entrepreneur (partner, tradesman, own account agricultural worker, liberal profession) without employees

Comprises persons with or without employees according to their entrepreneur activities. These are persons recorded in business register, in tradesmen register, persons conducting their entrepreneur activities on the base of special regulations (doctors, lawyers, experts, auditors, actors, self-employed farmers, etc.)

helping (non-paid) household members in a family enterprise Comprises persons working on the other base as a working-legal relation

other non-specified

Comprises all persons not included in one of previous categories and persons not included in work relation (e.g. graduates) and homekeeping persons.

16. Periodicity of journey to work or to school

To be filled in by the category working, by working pensioners, pupils, apprentices, students. Journey to work means the case the place of work or school is different from the place of permanent residence.

<u>daily</u>

Daily journey concerns everyday commuting to work or to school. Persons temporarily living at the place of work, school, (lodging house, as a subtenant, college) should state the periodicity of commuting from the place of temporary residence to work or to school as daily.

other than daily

Irregular commuting to work or to school (e.g. guard service, liberal profession, university students, etc.)

none

Concerns persons with the same address of permanent residence and that of place of work or school.

17. Time spent by daily journey to work or to school in minutes:

To be filled in by the category working, by working pensioners, pupils, apprentices, students.

It is the time spent by daily commuting to work or to school in minutes, from leaving the place of residence till registration at work or entering the school.

One way journey to work or to school should be written down.

18. Occupation

To be filled in by the category working, by working and non-working pensioners, unemployed and persons on maternity (parental) leave.

Non-working pensioners, persons on maternity (parental) leave, persons at military service, in prison and unemployed should write down the last occupation. Write down the kind of work, status or type of activity.

Persons not included in work relation till Census date (e.g. homekeeping, graduates) should not fill in this question.

19. Name and address of employer or school

The categories working and working pensioners should write down the current name and address of current employer. Pupils, apprentices, students should write down the name and address of the school.

Non-working pensioners, unemployed, persons at military service, in prison, persons on maternity (parental) leave should write down the current name and address of the last employer. In the case the employer or the school is situated abroad, write down the name of the country in the district row.

20. Place of work

Write down the complete address of the place of work, i.e. the real place of the activities conducted, which may be different from the address of employer

Persons changing the place of work often (e.g. assemblers) should write down the address of employer as place of work. Transportation workers should write down the place of starting. In the case of two occupations, the place of the main occupation should be written.

In the case the place of work is situated abroad, write down the name of the country in the district row.

Children up to 16, apprentices, high school students, university students, non-working pensioners and persons not included in work relation till Census date should not fill in this question.

21. First permanent residence

To be filled in by all persons except of foreigners

Permanent residence of mother at the date of birth of the enumerated person should be written down.

22. Address of permanent residence

To be filled in only by temperarily present persons and by foreigners.

23. Name and surname

To be filled in only by temporarily present persons and by foreigners.
