# Six month project extension announced at SC 2014





New York, 4 – 7 March 2014

The United Nations Statistics Division (UNSD) and UK Department for International Development (DFID) announced that the project on "Improving the Collation, Availability and Dissemination of Development Indicators, including MDGs" would be extended by a further 7 months until 31 January 2015 to concentrate on metadata production with the 11 project countries.

Phnom Penh, 21 – 25 April 2014

The fourth workshop of the UNSD-DFID project will take place in Phnom Penh, Cambodia in partnership with the National Institute of Statistics of Cambodia. Entitled "CountryData: Building better dissemination systems for national development indicators," the workshop will focus on outstanding issues in implementation, metadata and discrepancy analysis, further practice on the tools for sharing data in SDMX and with UNSD's <a href="CountryData">CountryData</a>, and will look forward to potential data demands from the Post-2015 development agenda and Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). #### Nairobi / Casablanca, 25 November - 5 December

The third workshop of the UNSD/DFID project was held in Nairobi back to back with a joint workshop organised with the United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Western Asia (UN ESCWA), held in Casablanca. Both workshops gave hands-on training in the use of technologies for dissemination and data exchange using SDMX tools for MDG Data Reporting. Practice and demonstration was given on tools like the UNSD developed features in <a href="DevInfo.7">DevInfo.7</a> and EuroStat's <a href="SDMX-RI">SDMX-RI</a>. As a result of latter workshop, three new countries were able to exchange data with CountryData; Egypt, Jordan and Yemen.
