Survey duplication on the same population leading to waste of scarce resources

Example: The NISR surveys hotels to determine nightly rates while the Rwanda Development Board surveys hotels to determine hotel services.

Why the National ...(cont'd)?

Missed opportunities for policy analysis:

(e.g. Rwanda Revenue Authority data only being used to record revenue collected but not used to examine if tax policies have influenced revenue collection levels)

■ Unusable data due to inconsistency in standards of classification:

(e.g. Customs dep't does not inform NISR that it excludes the cost of transport in valuing imports)

Why the National ... (cont'd)?

- Delays in production of national indicators:
 - e.g. Statistical Year Book compilation
- Lack of data portal leads to inadequate data dissemination and access
- Survey fatigue and inconsistencies in incentives may negatively affect the cooperation of respondents and data collection facilitators (e.g. Local leaders)

Why the National ...(cont'd)?

- Good statistic is key for:
- Evidence based-decision making
- Better policy formulation
- Efficient resource allocation.




Coordination tasks and responsibilities

- National Statistical System (NSS) Coordination NISR is in charge of:
- 1. **Provide technical support** to NSS institutions in the area of statistical activities;
- 2. Contribute to the conception and analysis of tasks on behalf on NISR and other statistical producers that **ensures application of visa**;
- 3. Strengthen technical coordination to ensure harmonisation of classification across NSS;
- 4. **Quality assurance** of all nationwide data collection activities.

Coordination tasks and responsibilities(cont'd)

- Capacity building (both NISR and NSS staff).
- Plan and organise both <u>professional and degree</u> <u>program trainings</u> to both NISR and NSS staff;
- Organise and supervise both <u>industrial</u>
 <u>attachments and internship programs</u> for young university graduates in Statistics;
- 3. Trainings and outreach workshops

Indicators neither produced by NISR nor by sectors, BUT required by the sectors

3. Progress made so far

- Strengthening Rwanda Administrative Data System through local capacity development in data production & management within (Education, Agriculture, Health and Population (Civil registration);
- Deployment of administrative data collection tools in the whole country;(514 administrative sectors)
- ToRs for technical working group (Agriculture, Governance....) on statistical coordination approved;
- Statistical capacity building of key NSS institutions continuously built;
- strengthened data and microdata dissemination and their accessibility to the users

4. The way forward: Priority 1 of NSDS2

- 1 Consolidate coordination and capacity development within NSS
- 2 Strengthen administrative data and vital statistics production
- 3 Ensure disaggregated data availability
- 4 Ensure access of regularly updated data in machine readable formats
- 5 Integrate use of statistics in policy formulation and decision making

The way forward (Cont'd)

- Statistical capacity building will continue(trainings, outreach workshops,...)
- □ Joint (NISR and NSS institutions) thematic analysis and district profiles to be conducted and produced;
- Support NSS sectors during the EDPRS 2 elaboration (baseline and metadata);
- Develop and validate the information dissemination policy;
- Validation and promotion the use of standards classification manuals (ISIC4, ISCO 08, ISCED 97);
- High level Rwanda Statistics Council/Federation in place for promoting and protecting the statistics professionalism, etc.
