This report present the results of the task team over the period November 2015 – August 2016

These results are outcomes of the efforts devoted by the task team members and the day-to-day support provided by the UNSD and focal point for this project.

1) Achievements by the TT since the last GWG meeting:

- Preparation on Third Big Data Conference Day 2 on Training and Capacity Building (including design of the programme and selecting speakers).
- Drafting GWG training courses in the use of Big Data for official statistics that taking into account existing courses on big data, and the needs of certain topics.
- Preparation on training workshop in using Satellite data to compile crop yield statistics in collaboration with ABS (Nov 2016 in Chiba [with UN SIAP], Japan and April 2017 in Bogota, Columbia [with DANE])

3) Future work plan of the TT

- Execution of training workshop on Satellite data in Japan and Columbia
- Implementing GWG training programme in cooperation with ABS/QUT, ESTP (European Statistical Training Programme) and FutureLearn.com/QUT. [i.e., raising awareness, funding countries to attend those courses, etc.]
- Developing necessary courses (based on the roadmap of GWG training courses) [in cooperation with UN SIAP]

- Compiling various compilation guidelines from other TTs and making them available on online platform (such as wiki)
- Conducting follow up survey related to skills, training and capacity building

Task Team objectives:

- a. Develop methods and tools (including coordination and facilitation) for
 - i. a baseline need identification of Big Data skills in NSSs; and
 - ii. an assessment of institutional readiness of NSSs in using Big Data
- b. Provide guidance on the development of a programme of training that addresses the gaps identified in the skills needs analysis
- c. Facilitate establishing global network of institutions for training and capacity building on Big Data
- d. Coordinate training plans in line with Global Survey on Big Data for Official Statistics and other outcomes from tasks teams formulated within GWG.
