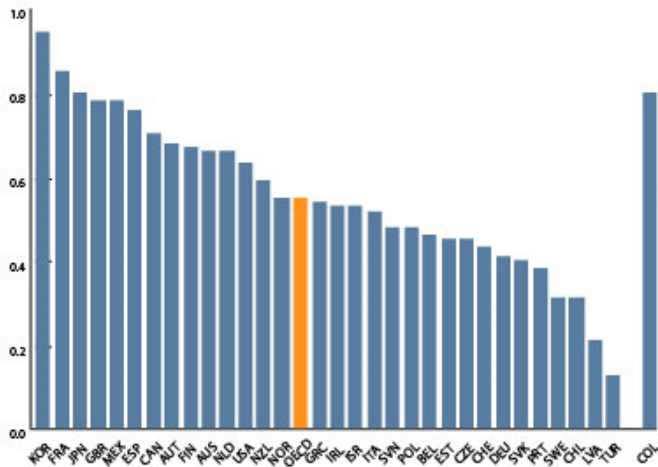

Road gained in the quality and reliability of the open data

- **Reliable Data**, this data is published by government agencies at their highest level of disaggregation.
- **System Integrity**, Socrata's Open Data Portal is included in Gartner's list of renown providers of open data portals according to Gartner, December 15, 2016.

- **Metadata**, has been defined in order to strengthen the context of the data, geolocation and follow-up to its rigorous completion, thus facilitating access and reuse of data.
- **Standards**, Socrata's Open Data Portal supports a wide range of data formats and metadata standards to ensure that the data is always open and interoperable. Some of the open formats that are supported are JSON, CSV, GeoJSON, DCAT and data.json

CITIZENS EVALUATION

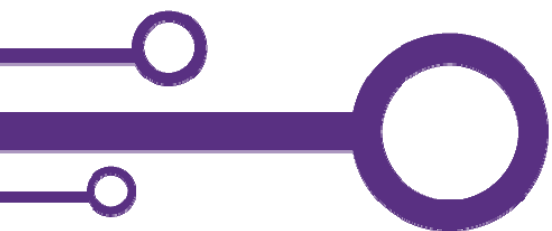
Through the Label of Excellence model. The user becomes the protagonist, by certifying and verifying the quality of the data.

GPS for individuals with visual impairment or total blindness

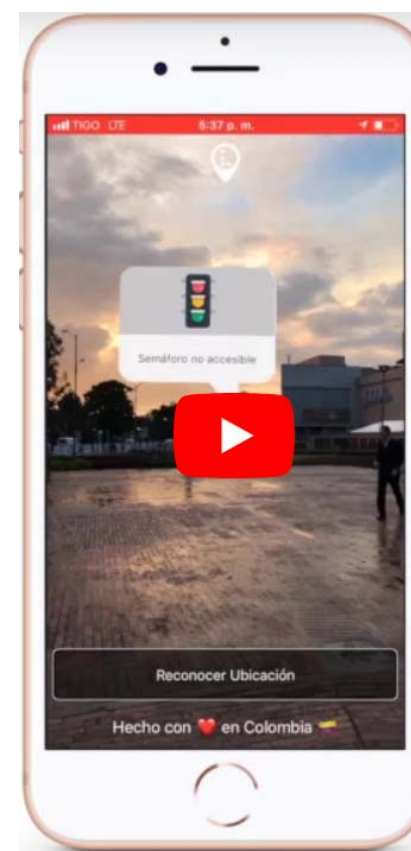
