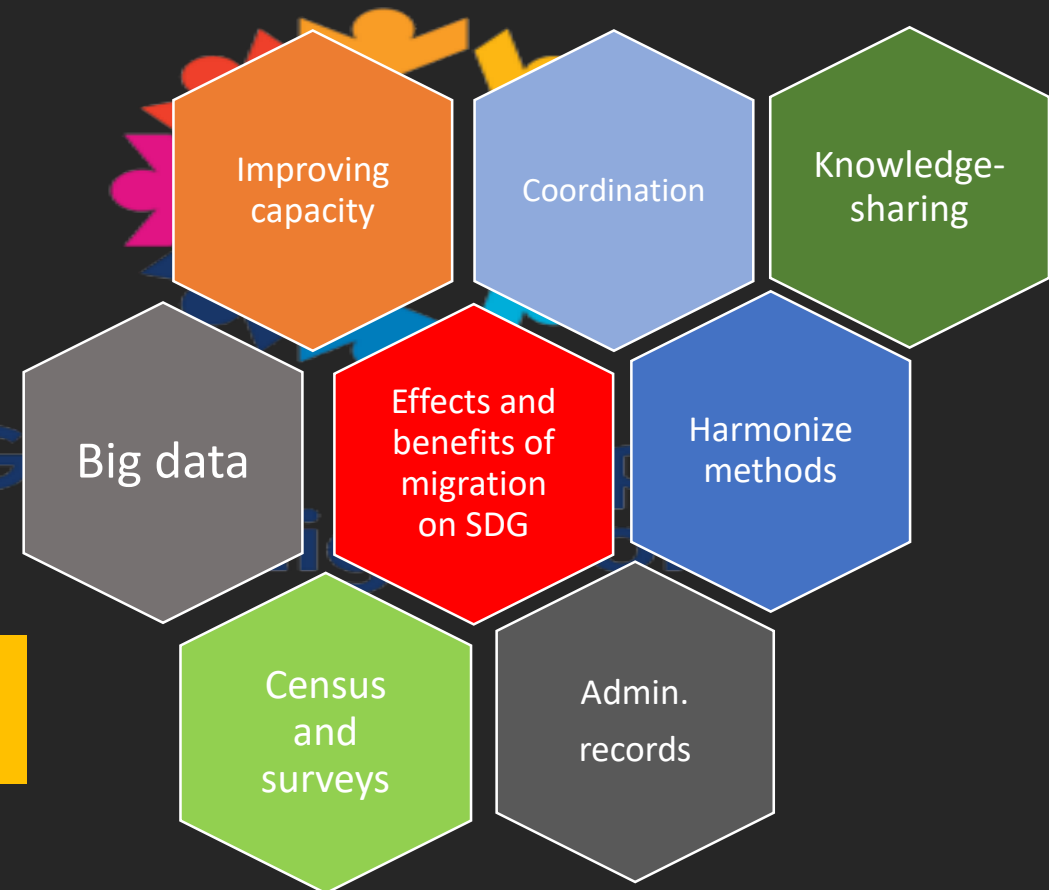
Global Compact for Safe, Orderly and Regular Migration

- Objective 1: Collect and utilize accurate and disaggregated data as a basis for evidence-based policies

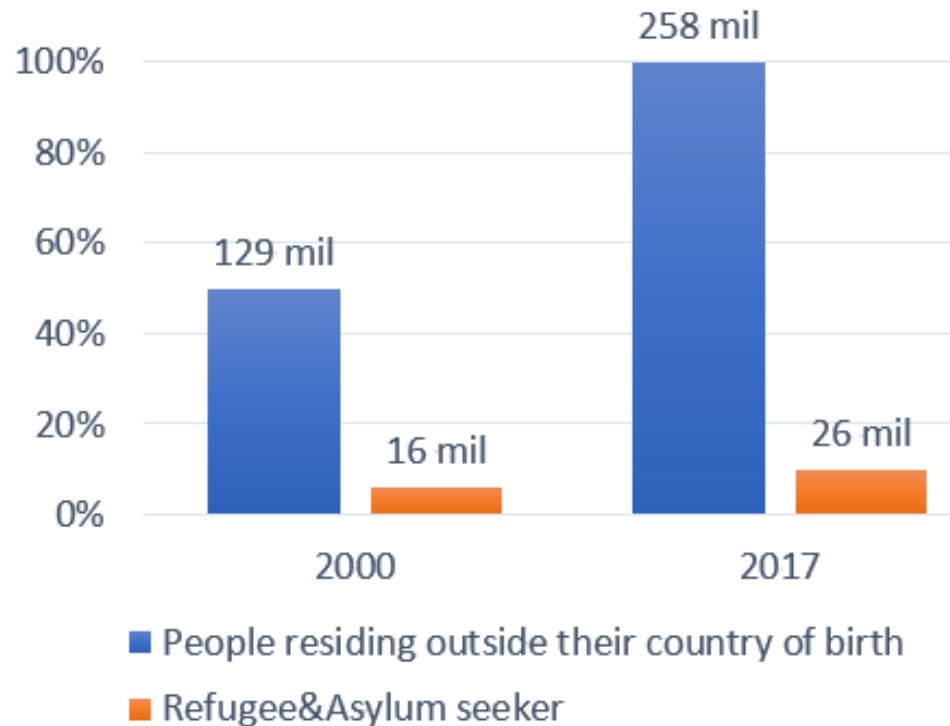


Raised the profile and importance of data and statistics

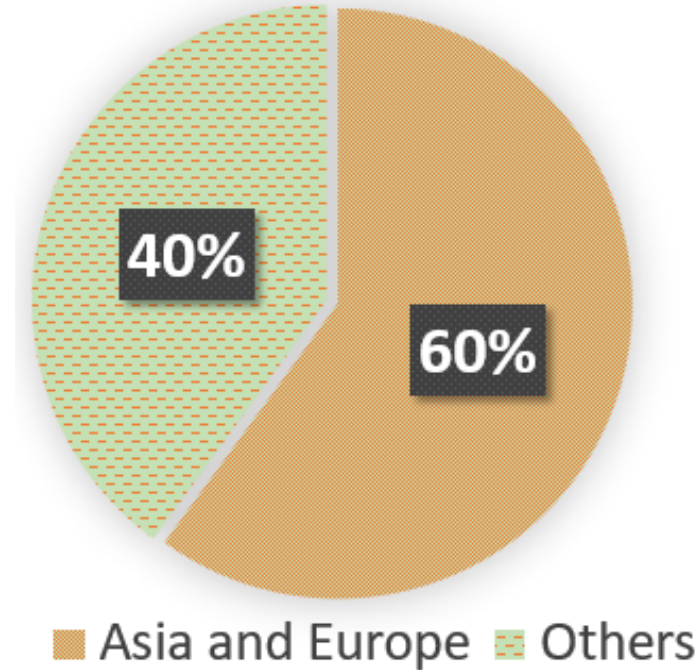
Put significant pressure on countries' statistical capacity to fulfil new migration data requirements



What do we know about international migrants?

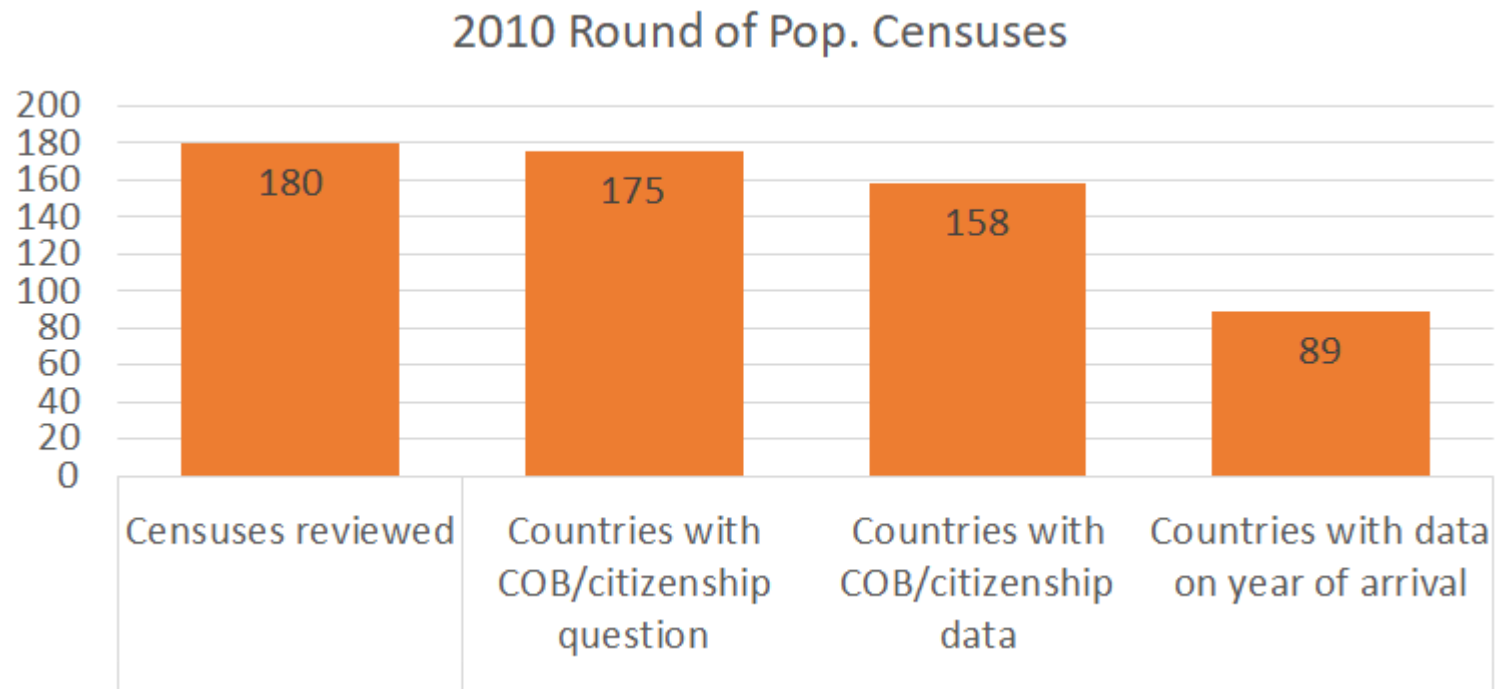


1 every 30 people

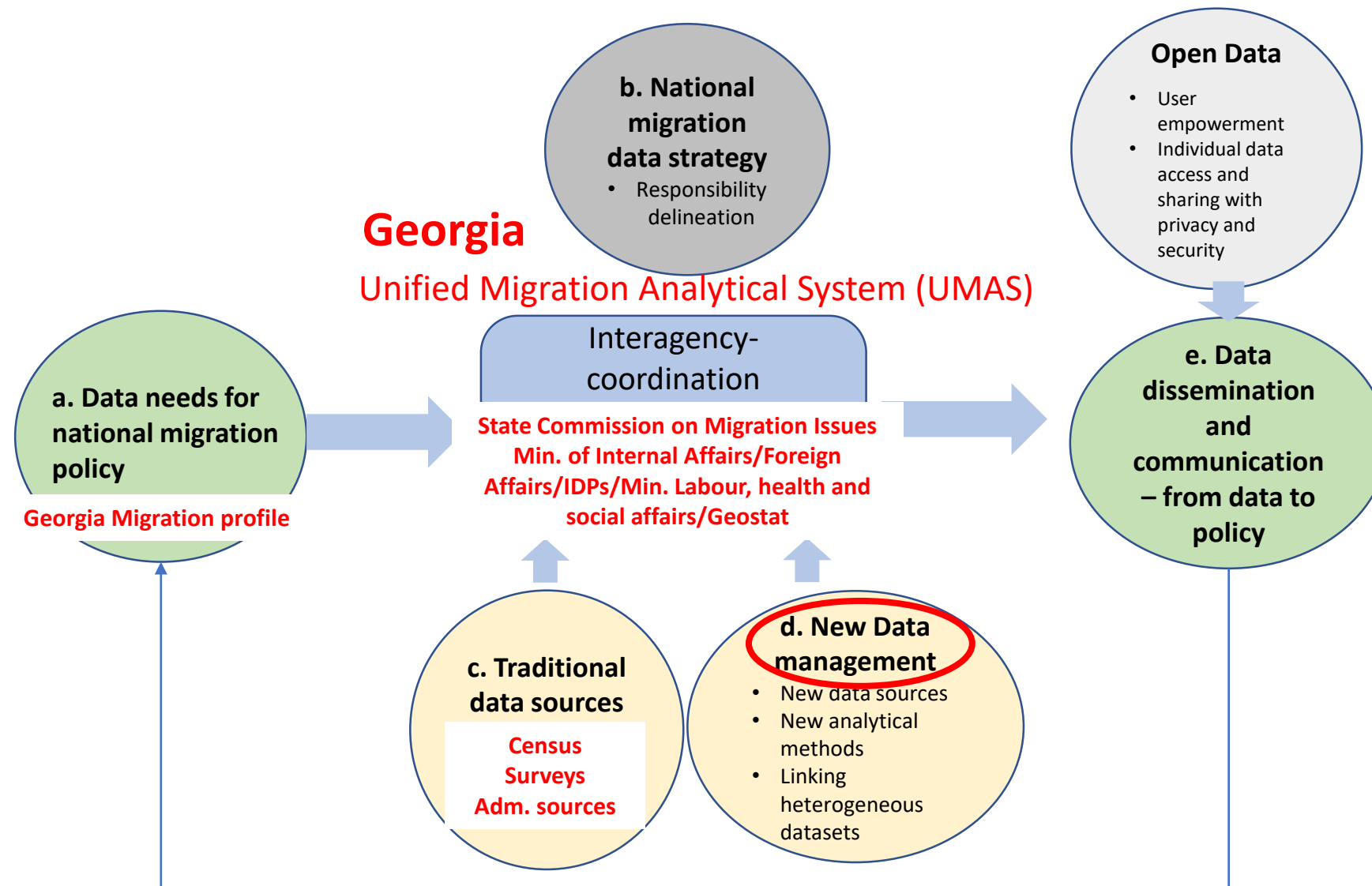
