





## Compiling Informal and household trade as part of HIBTS

UNCEBTS 8<sup>th</sup> Meeting 24 June, Singapore

### Background

- The activities and progress done by the UN Committee of Experts on Business and Trade Statistics and its task teams were presented at the 56th session of the UN Statistical Commission.
- One of the discussions focused on the White Cover version of the Handbook on Integrating Business and Trade Statistics (HIBTS), which the Commission endorsed. It also welcomed the implementation strategy and stressed the importance of capacity development.
- Likewise, the Commission requested the exploration of the inclusion of informal and household trade in the Handbook.

### **Objective**

Prepare a guidance note on the measurement of Informal Cross-Border Trade (ICBT) and Household (HH) trade from a business perspective, supporting the production of statistics in countries where these forms of trade are significant, addressing data needs from users, and supporting the design and evaluation of policies.

# Starting point for the development of the conceptual framework

This proposal will consider, as a starting point, that ICBT may be carried out by different economic units.

Recognizing the different challenges and data availability associated with ICBT and formal trade carried out by households, it is proposed to address them separately and provide specific recommendations for each one.
